Power Savings Bonus – program extended!

Good news! The Power Saving Bonus has been extended.

The new program starts on 01 July 2022 and will run until 31 December 2022. Households that have previously claimed the \$250 Power Saving Bonus **will still be eligible** for the new one-off payment.

The Victorian Government is easing cost-of-living pressures and encouraging Victorians to get a better deal on their energy - and save money - by encouraging all households to apply for the new \$250 Power Saving Bonus. The new bonus will be **open to all Victorian households**, not just concession card holders.

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ADULT MIGRANT ENGLISH PROGRAM (AMEP)

The Adult Migrant English Program (AMEP) provides free English language tuition to eligible migrants and humanitarian entrants. AMEP is funded by the Australian Government Department of Home Affairs. AMEP helps clients to learn English as well as to participate socially and economically in Australian society. You may be eligible for AMEP if you have been

- granted a permanent visa OR
- granted an eligible temporary visa AND
- speak little or no English

Young people between 15 and 17 years of age may also be eligible.

In an AMEP class you will learn English language skills and information about Australian society.

You can meet other people learning English. Classes are taught by qualified teachers. For further information about AMEP please contact us.





SKILLS FOR EDUCATION AND EMPLOYMENT (SEE)

The Skills for Education and Employment (SEE) program assists clients to gain employment by strengthening their language, literacy and numeracy skills. SEE is a free program for eligible jobseekers and is funded by the Australian Government Department of Education, Skills and Employment. SEE is flexible, with both part-time and full-time options. SEE caters for clients with English as an additional language or as a first language. It also caters for clients of all ages.
