HOW THE SYSTEM WORKS:

A Book Pack will be ordered automatically for each child enrolled at Teesdale Primary School in 2022. You do not need to do anything!

If this arrangement is <u>NOT</u> suitable for your child, please contact the school office by Friday 10th December, 2021, so we do not order more than is required.

STANDARD BOOK PACK:

Teesdale Primary School book pack purchased through Winc Education provides parents with high quality items at a lower than catalogue price, according to year levels. Your child may not require every item, but because the book packs are supplied direct to school as standard issue, it is cheaper to leave all items on the list. Parents may choose to provide or purchase some items themselves. If you choose to do this, you must consult with the school so that your child has the right items.

PAYMENT:

Payment is not required until January 2022.

All parent payments and contributions can be made electronically by BPay with the School's Biller Code 87361 and your unique family Reference Code. Please contact the office if you do not know your code.

The Book Box will be <u>delivered to your child's classroom</u>, ready for the first day of school.

Voluntary contributions may be paid in regular instalments.

If BPay is not an option for you, please contact the school office to make alternative arrangements.
