The Performing Arts Ensemble (PAE) program covers vocal and instrumental music and dance ensembles and is tailored to meet the differing abilities and experience of students. Registration for all ensembles is required on enrolment.

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### Benefits of Ensemble participation

- ♪ Being a member of an ensemble fosters friendship, discipline, teamwork, personal organisation, hand/eye/ear coordination of music repertoire, sight reading and working towards personal and team goals.
- ♪ Advanced players in ensembles can be extended by being featured in performance works and becoming section leaders.

### Ensemble enrolment – Year 7 students and other new enrolments

- ♪ Complete an enrolment form provided in the Year 7 enrolment pack.
- ♪ Rehearsals will commence in Week 3, Term 1.
- ♪ Invoices for Fees will be sent out mid Term 1.

### Guidelines of Ensemble participation

- ♪ Students must receive private tuition
- ♪ Be prompt for the rehearsal, set up and pack up the room
- ♪ Attend rehearsals with your MUSIC and a PENCIL
- ♪ Black PAE Shirt is compulsory for performances and is available for purchase from the uniform shop. Students will also need a pair of plain, black dress trousers and black shoes.
- ♪ Participation in the Stage Band firstly requires membership of a Concert Band



## Leaving an Ensemble

- Ensembles run for the entire year and written confirmation by parents is required if students wish to leave early. If the student leaves the music program during the year, no refund of fees will be paid.

## Music Program Fees

- Ensemble fees are necessary to cover the costs of employing the PAE coordinator, Ensemble directors and choreographers, maintenance of equipment, competition entry fees, transport and the purchase of music and instruments.
