WHAT WILL I DO BETWEEN DROPPING MY CHILD OFF AND WHEN THE CEREMONY STARTS?

Given the locality of the venue, some parents choose to go home after dropping their child off at 5.30pm and come back at 6.20pm, with the ceremony starting at 6.30pm. Some parents choose to stay at the venue and wait in their cars outside the venue. **Unfortunately, parents are not allowed to wait inside the venue.**

There is no strict dress code for the evening. Students are encouraged to dress nicely for the evening but this does not mean that they have to have a formal suit or dress.
