As winter approaches and the Brimbank community continues to be impacted by COVID-19 as well as the cold and flu season, it is a timely reminder for us to protect ourselves and our loved ones. The Victorian Government is providing free flu vaccinations for everyone aged six months and over.

Council's Neighbourhood Houses and Community Centres returned to Term 2 with full service! This included resuming full opening hours, re-introducing programs at the Centres, recommencing hire groups with function hire and the return of community events. We hosted Yarning Circles, Author and Artist talks, Exhibitions, a Cultural Infusion event, Neighbour Day and Neighbourhood House Week events.

We also held a series of pop up morning and afternoon tea events to provide an opportunity for the community to share their ideas and needs. Staff met with program participants, community groups, stakeholders and importantly, members of our community. The sessions also provided staff the opportunity to check in with community members who have been absent from our spaces post COVID lockdown.

We gained a wealth of knowledge from this experience. Feedback received was not only positive, but also identified ways to complement our existing programs to better meet community needs. An immediate outcome from these sessions includes community led initiatives such as more physical activity at no charge. Community members identified areas for improvement and indicated they would like to continue such discussions on a more regular basis.
