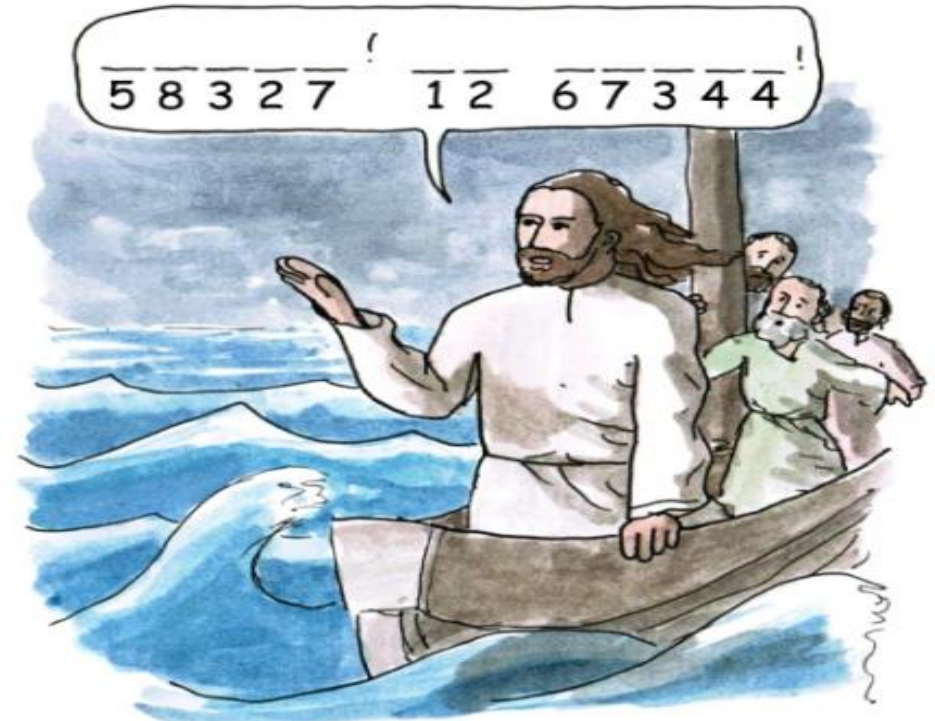

Saint Josemaria Escriva

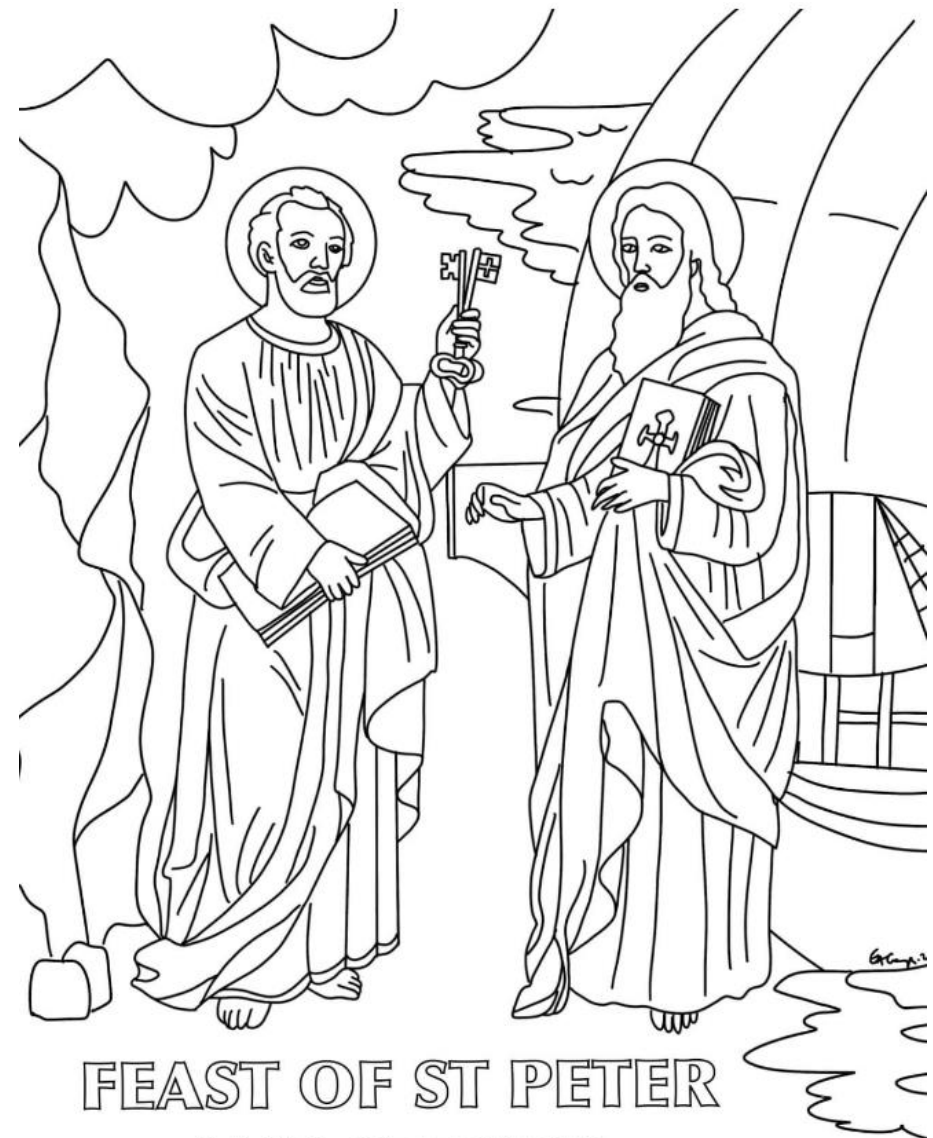
26 June
