- 1.0 POLICY AND PROCEDURE

1.1 Policy

Many students attending school need medication to control illnesses such as asthma and epilepsy and conditions causing hyperactive behaviour. The student's continued attendance at school and benefit

from education is dependent on this therapy. It is necessary that the school, as part of its duty fo care, assist students where it is appropriate to take their medication. Parent Authorisation for a staff member to administer Medication <u>Child's Name:</u> <u>Grade:</u> **Medication Supplied** (If ongoing treatment then one week's supply to be provided to the class teacher on the first school day each week **EXCEPT** in the case of Ritalin and Dexamphetimine.
