Music Program Overview

The Performing Arts Ensemble (PAE) program covers many types of vocal, instrumental music and dance styles and is tailored to meet the differing abilities and experience of students. Registration for all ensembles is required on Enrolment Day.

Ensemble enrolment – Year 7 students and other new enrolments

- Complete an enrolment form provided in the Year 7 enrolment pack.
- Attend an ensemble rehearsal. The PAE Coordinator can advise which ensemble will be most suitable.
- Rehearsals will commence in Term 1, Week 2.
- Invoices for Fees will be sent out mid Term 1.

Benefits of ensemble participation

- Being a member of an ensemble fosters friendship, discipline, teamwork, personal organisation, hand/eye/ear coordination of music repertoire, sight reading and working towards personal and team goals.
- Advanced players in ensembles can be extended by being featured in performance works and becoming section leaders.

Guidelines of Ensemble participation

- Students <u>must</u> receive private tuition
- Be prompt for the rehearsal, set up and pack up the room
- Attend rehearsals with your MUSIC and a PENCIL
- Black PAE Shirt is compulsory for performances and is available for purchase from the uniform shop. Students will also need a pair of plain, black dress trousers and black shoes.
- Participation in the Stage Band/Wind Ensemble firstly requires membership of a Concert Band

Leaving an ensemble

This can only be permitted with a written request from a parent. If the student leaves the music program during the year, no refund of fees will be paid.

Instruments

All instruments cases are to be clearly marked with Student Name, Mobile Number, School Name and School Phone Number.

- All Percussionists must own stick/mallets.
- All instruments should be stored in C Block or in the student's locker.
- Students and parents are required to keep a record of the serial number of their instrument regardless of whether it is hired or owned.
- Loss of an instrument must be immediately reported to the PAE program coordinator and the police.
- Keep your instrument clean and do not let other students 'play' your instrument.

Festivals, School and Public Performances

Traditionally the instrumental ensembles enter the Sydney Eisteddfod, State Band Championships, North Shore Schools Spectacular and perform at Primary Schools in our local area each year. There is a fine standard of music and Killara High School regularly attains awards. Two performance evenings are held over the course of the year and each ensemble will each be given the opportunity to perform. It is compulsory for students to attend these performances.
