To celebrate and encourage vocational education in our region, the members of Soroptimist International Griffith are very pleased to be offering one \$1000 Vocational Education Grant to a woman participating in vocational training in 2021, through online learning, Griffith TAFE NSW, WRCC or Country Universities Centre.

The applicant needs to be currently enrolled in a full-time course which leads to employment. The grant is offered to assist with educational resources and/or course fees.

The successful applicant will be determined by an SI Griffith committee.

To be eligible, applicants must:

- Be female.
- Be a resident of Griffith for twelve months or more.
- Currently enrolled in a full-time vocational education course at TAFENSW or WRCC or Country Universities Centre in Griffith or online.
- Be an Australian, an Australian permanent resident or holder of a permanent humanitarian visa.
- Complete an application form.
- Demonstrate a commitment to study and have career aspirations (provide a personal statement not more than 200 words).
- Provide two referee statements to support your application. (*Please note referees cannot be related to you.*)
- <u>Academic</u> from a person competent to comment on your capacity to undertake/continue tertiary studies e.g., academic mentor, tutor
- <u>Character</u>- from a person competent to comment on your suitability for the grant e.g., supervisor, employer
