La Trobe University Aspire Early Admissions Program

Selection is based on: written application about history of community service/ leadership/ volunteerism, ATAR predicted by school, referee.

If you receive a place in the program, you will receive a guaranteed place in your desired course if you: achieve the required minimum ATAR set by the University and meet eligibility criteria for the course.

Application process:

- Apply for the course via VTAC.
- Apply for Aspire direct to La Trobe. Applications open 1 June.

Australian Catholic University Community Achievers Program

Selection is based on: written application about history of community service/ leadership/ volunteerism, academic reports, referee.

If you receive a place in the program, you will receive a guaranteed place in your desired course if you: achieve the required minimum ATAR set by the University and meet eligibility criteria for the course.

Application process:

- Apply for the course via VTAC.
- Apply for the program direct to Australian Catholic University. Applications open 1 May.

Victoria University Early Entry Offer Program

Eligibility: one or more of the following categories,

a) leadership, b) educational disadvantage or c) being a student at an eligible school.

If you receive a place in the program, you will receive a guaranteed place in your desired course if you: achieve the required minimum ATAR set by the University and meet eligibility criteria for the course.

Application process:

- Apply for the course via VTAC.
- Apply for the program direct to Victoria University. Applications open in August.

RMIT Schools Network Access Program

Eligibility: student at an eligible school.

May be considered for RMIT courses below the clearly in ATAR and minimum English prerequisite study score. Must meet eligibility criteria for the course.

Application process:

- Apply for the course via VTAC.
- Apply for the Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS) via VTAC between 6 August – 27 September and tick yes for category 1 (Personal Information and Location).
- Be endorsed by your school.

Guaranteed Entry Schemes - Vic

University of Melbourne Access Melbourne

Guaranteed entry with a lower ATAR set by the University of Melbourne.

Eligibility: meet at least one of the following criteria

- Disadvantaged financial background.
- Live in a rural or isolated area.
- Indigenous Australian.

Plus, meet guaranteed minimum ATAR and eligibility criteria for your course.

Application Process

- Apply for the course through VTAC between 6 August – 27 September.
- Fill out relevant SEAS category via VTAC – Personal Information and Location and/or Disadvantaged Financial Circumstances between 6 August and 12 October.

Monash University Monash Guarantee

Guaranteed entry with a lower ATAR set by Monash University.

Eligibility: meet at least one of the following criteria

- Have experienced financial disadvantage.
- Live in a low socio-economic area.
- Attend a Monash list under-represented school.
- Are an Indigenous Australian.

Plus, meet guaranteed minimum ATAR and eligibility criteria for your course.

Application Process

- Apply for the course through VTAC between 6 August – 27 September.
- Fill out relevant SEAS category via VTAC – Personal Information and Location and/or Disadvantaged Financial Circumstances between 6 August and 12 October.

Schools Recommendation Schemes (SRS) are one way NSW and Canberra institutions make early offers of undergraduate admission to Year 12 students, using criteria other than (or in addition to) the ATAR,

What is the Application Process?

- 1) Apply for your desired course/s via the University Admissions Centre (UAC) between Wednesday 1 August – Friday 28 September.
- 2) Login to the Schools Recommendation Schemes portal using your UAC login details.
- 3) Complete the application between Wednesday 1 August – Friday 28 September.
- 4) The school will receive your application, and a staff member will complete the rating/endorsement form.
- 5) Offers will be made via UAC later in the year (either November or December). If successful, you will receive a conditional or non-conditional offer.

It is important to note that each universities entry scheme is different, and not all courses are eligible for early entry.

Early Entry Schemes – NSW

University of New England Direct Early Entry

Selection is based on: recommendation from your school. Your final ATAR isn't taken into consideration.

If you receive a place in the program, you will receive a guaranteed place in your desired course in early November for the 2019 intake. You will need to meet the selection criteria for the course.

Application process:

- Apply for up to three courses direct to University of New England (not all courses are eligible).
- Applications are now open.

University of Wollongong Early Admission

Selection is based on: written application about history of community service/ leadership/ volunteerism, Year 11 and 12 academic results, interview.

If you receive a place in the program, you will receive a guaranteed place in your desired course before you receive your ATAR.

Application process:

- Apply for up to two University of Wollongong courses via UAC between Wednesday 1 August – Friday 28 September.
- Apply for the Early Admission program directly to University of Wollongong between 1 - 24 August.

Selection is based on: written application about history of community service/ leadership/ volunteerism, academic reports, referee.

- Apply for the course via UAC.
- Apply for the program direct to Australian Catholic University. Applications open 1 May.
