- One in five children experience online bullying but only 2.1% report it to a teacher.
- Girls are about twice as likely as boys to be victims and perpetrators of cyber bullying.
- More than 80% of boys aged 15+ access pornography weekly.
- One third of children under 8 have tried to access pornographic content.

Kate Wilde, educator, counsellor and development worker, will provide essential information and resources you can access to protect your children online and navigate the internet safely together.

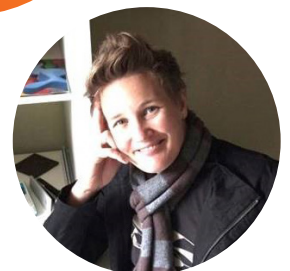
