Our school has a formal uniform policy endorsed by the P&C, SRC and school staff. Students at Glen Innes High School are required to abide by the dress code at all times.



If your child has a genuine reason for not wearing the correct school uniform, please send her/him to school with a dated, handwritten explanation. This note should be presented to the office staff upon arrival at school.

If your child needs uniform items, please approach the office to borrow or buy items from our Clothing Pool or request a 'Student Assistance Application Form' for financial support.

If your child has outgrown their uniform or is leaving the school, please consider donating their uniform to our Clothing Pool. Donations can be left at the school office.

On occasion, students may be asked to wear formal dress uniform.

- Formal dress uniform for girls consists of: long GIHS tartan skirt, white business style shirt, school tie, stockings, black court shoes, woollen royal blue jumper and/or blazer with school insignia.
- Formal dress uniform for boys consists of: long grey trousers, white business style shirt, school tie, woollen royal blue jumper and/or blazer with school insignia, grey socks and black dress shoes.

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Junior (Years 7 - 10) Girls' Uniform

- **Skirt** blue GIHS tartan: short straight, short pleated or long pleated (preferred over shorts/trousers). Black stockings can be worn with tartan skirt in winter and on cold days.
- Shorts/Trousers tailored, plain navy blue with no logo
- Shirt GIHS shirt: sky blue polo top with navy blue collar and school insignia
- Jumper royal blue or navy blue with school insignia or any navy blue jumper with no logo or hood
- Jacket GIHS jacket: navy blue with yellow panels, yellow piping and school insignia, or plain navy blue jacket with no logo
- Socks white or navy
- Shoes black, fully enclosed, WH&S compliant
- Hats/Caps navy blue with school insignia or navy blue (with no promotion of alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc.)
- Undershirt white or blue

- Shirt GIHS shirt: sky blue polo top with navy blue collar and school insignia

- **Jacket** GIHS jacket: navy blue with yellow panels, yellow piping and school insignia, or plain navy blue jacket with no logo
- Socks grey, white or navy

- **Jacket** GIHS jacket: navy blue with yellow panels, yellow piping and school insignia, or plain navy blue jacket with no logo
- Socks white or navy

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Sport and PDHPE (unisex) Uniform

Sport uniform is to be worn on Sport Days: Tuesdays for Year 7 and 8 students, Thursdays for Year 9 and 10 students. Sport uniform is also to be worn in designated PDHPE lessons as directed by the class teacher, students are to get changed in change rooms.

- Shorts/Track Pants navy blue with no logo
- **Shirts** GIHS shirt: sky blue polo top with navy blue collar and school insignia (the same as for non-sport days). Please note that the GIHS sport shirt white with navy blue sleeves and collar and school insignia will no longer be a uniform item after 2022
- Socks white
- Shoes sport shoes
- **Jacket** GIHS jacket: navy blue with yellow panels, yellow piping and school insignia, or plain navy blue jacket with no logo
- **Hats/Caps** navy blue with school insignia or navy blue (with no promotion of alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc.)
- **HPU uniform** High Performance Unit (HPU) students are to wear their HPU uniform in designated lessons only, they cannot wear it for the whole day of an HPU lesson.
