Bikes and pets   

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

Accessibility 

If you need help or cannot board a replacement bus or tram service, please contact PTV prior to travelling on 1800 800 007.

Instructions will be in place at the bus stops for you to arrange alternative transport at no cost. Staff will also be on-site during the day at certain locations to assist.

Edithvale, Chelsea and Bonbeach station closures

Edithvale, Chelsea and Bonbeach stations will close from **Sunday 25 July** and the new stations will open in **November 2021**.

From **9pm Sunday 25 July to last service Sunday 1 August**, buses will replace trains on sections of the Frankston and Stony Point lines. A train replacement and community shuttle bus will run as a loop service.

Ticketing and station facilities

While the stations are closed, station facilities and myki readers will not be available.

You should touch on and off at Mordialloc, Aspendale or Carrum stations. New myki card purchases or myki top ups can be made at Mordialloc and Carrum stations.

Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.

Changes to local buses

Several local bus services will be affected by these works, including bus routes 706 and 902 in Edithvale and bus routes 706, 858 and 902 in Chelsea. See the bus route changes and affected bus stops online at ptv.vic.gov.au/frankston

Pedestrian crossings closed

From **Sunday 25 July to early October 2021** there will be changes to how you move around the area, including pedestrian rail crossing closures, to ensure the safety of the community and workers.

During this time, you can cross the rail line at the following locations which are also marked on the map:

- Aspendale Station level crossing, Aspendale
- Lochiel Avenue level crossing, Edithvale
- Berry Avenue, Edithvale
- Swanpool Avenue, Chelsea
- Patterson River underpass, Carrum
- McLeod Road, Carrum

You can also cross the rail line via Golden Avenue, Bonbeach from **Sunday 25 July to Sunday 1 August 2021**.

Station closure and community shuttle bus

From **Monday 2 August**, Frankston Line trains will run express through the closed Edithvale, Chelsea and Bonbeach stations.

A combined station closure and community shuttle bus will operate between Mordialloc and Carrum to allow you to cross the rail line and to connect you to Frankston Line trains.

The shuttle bus will run as a loop service, with Mordialloc-bound stops located on Nepean Highway and Carrum-bound stops located on Station Street. The shuttle will stop at replacement bus stops between Mordialloc and Carrum as well as Berry Avenue, Golden Avenue, Swanpool Avenue and Lochiel Avenue.

The shuttle will run daily from:
– Mon to Thurs: 4am to 1am
– Fri to Sun: 24 hours

The shuttle will run to a 5-10 minute frequency. Please keep in mind that the frequency is subject to local traffic conditions.

Road disruptions and level crossing closures

There will be road and traffic disruptions on Nepean Highway and Station Street in Edithvale, Chelsea and Bonbeach.

Between **Monday 19 July and Sunday 25 July** the following level crossing will close to vehicles:

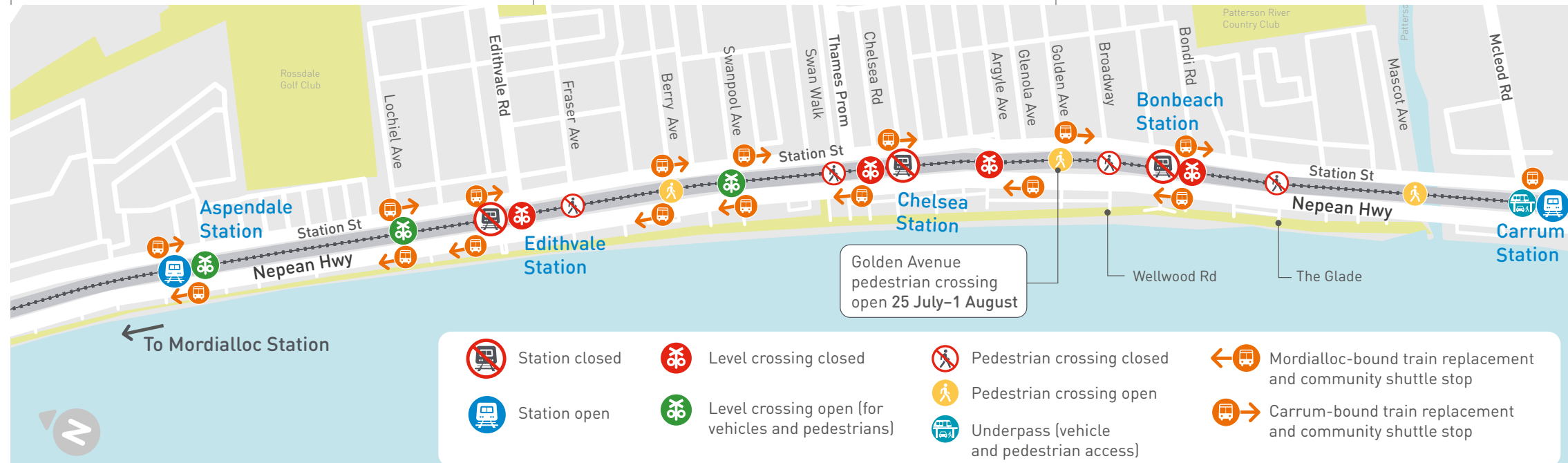
- Edithvale Road, Edithvale
- Chelsea Road, Chelsea
- Argyle Avenue, Chelsea
- Bondi Road, Bonbeach

Pedestrian access across these level crossings will close from **9pm Sunday 25 July**.

Traffic management and signage will be in place to help guide you safely around the area.

New road connections will open to vehicles and pedestrians in **early October 2021**.

We're busy removing level crossings

As part of Victoria's Big Build's \$3 billion upgrade of the Frankston Line, we're removing 18 level crossings and building 12 new stations, to improve safety, reduce congestion and allow more trains to run more often.

This year, we're removing five dangerous and congested level crossings from Edithvale to Bonbeach by lowering sections of the Frankston Line into a trench. Three new stations will be built at Edithvale, Chelsea and Bonbeach as part of the project with improved connections between trains and local transport including buses, taxis and bike storage facilities. These changes will make it safer and easier for locals to access public transport, local shops and the beach.

Construction on these projects started in 2020, with the five level crossings to be removed and new stations open in late-2021. For more information, visit levelcrossings.vic.gov.au

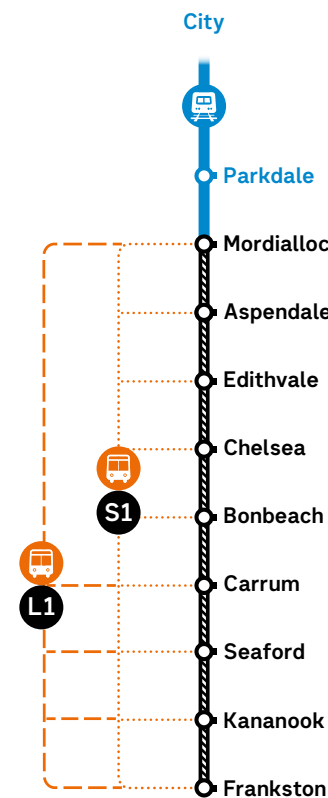

9pm to last service each night, Monday 19 to Thursday 22 July

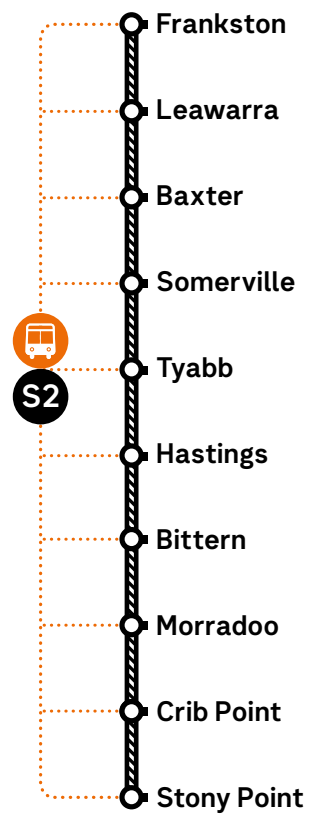

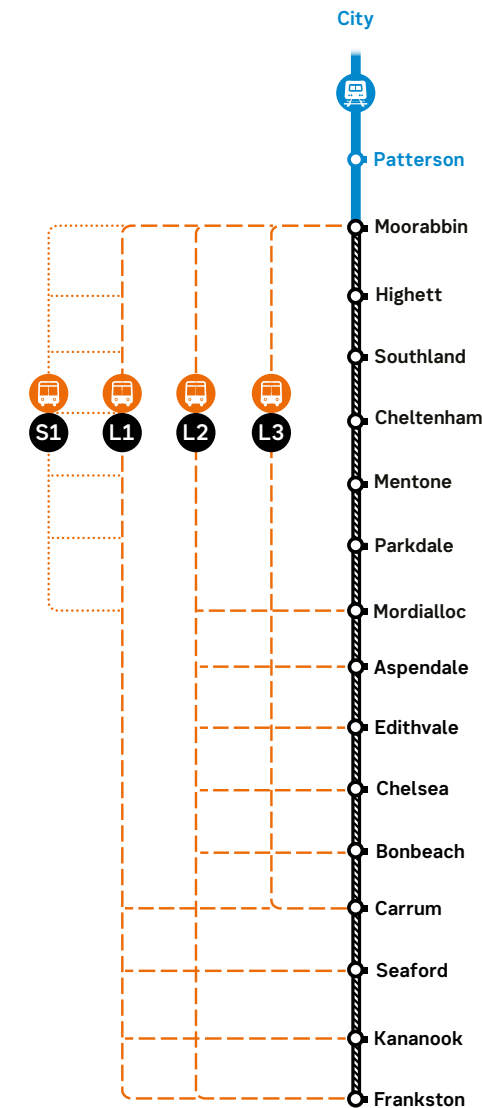


Weekend works between Frankston and Stony Point

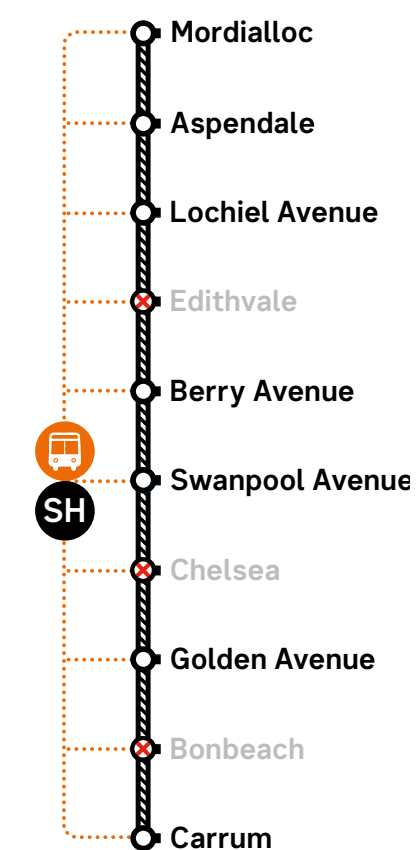
