Process for Selection

In applying for a House Captain position for 2026, please write a short speech outlining your skills, leadership qualities and experience. Speeches should be typed and formatted in size 12 font. Your speech should be between 2-3 minutes in length.

Please address the following in your speech: -

- *Explain why you would like to be a House Captain and outline your leadership qualities.*
- *Outline what you will do as a House Captain to build a culture of sportsmanship and community spirit within our school?*

Process

1. *Please submit a **copy** of your speech by the due date*
2. *You will deliver your speech to your Year 5 peers on Wednesday 19th November, Session 5*
3. *All Year 5 students will nominate three (3) peers using a ballot form*
4. *Mrs Northridge and Principal Class will finalise the House Leaders for 2026*
5. *House Captains will be notified once the School/SRC Captain process has been finalised*

It is important that you are well prepared to deliver your speech. Please take the time to practice your speech before Wednesday 19th November. It is an expectation that House Captains will speak regularly at assembly and other whole school events. This will be the first step in preparing you for the public speaking role that comes with being a House Captain.

This process is an excellent experience for all students who wish to pursue leadership roles at WPS in 2026 and in their secondary school years.

Speeches are due to Mrs Northridge by 3.00 pm on Friday 14th November 2025.
