# What We Are Learning In...

# Reading

These are some of the reading strategies we will be focusing on this term:

#### **COMPREHENSION:**

- Retelling the key events and summarising
- Making connections with the text
- Locating information in the text
- · Questioning

#### **DECODING/ACCURACY:**

Continue using strategies such as chunking, cross checking, skipping the word and then coming back, flipping the sound, re-reading to self-correct etc.

#### FLUENCY:

- Paying attention to punctuation
- Reading with expression
- Reading rate/pace
   read not too fast
   and not too slow

#### **VOCABULARY:**

- Looking at the text that comes before and after the unknown word to understand it's meaning
  - Reading a variety of texts, fiction and nonfiction, to expand vocabulary (using tools like glossaries, dictionaries and thesauruses)
