<u>SENIOR HORSEMANSHIP (YEAR 6 – Year 12) Term 1, 2018</u> <u>THAC PIC 3GMUH464</u>

This form is to be completed and returned to Senior Campus Reception as soon as possible please.

Senior Horsemanship lessons are held on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons from 4:00 - 5:30 pm. Students are divided into experience based groups. Senior Horsemanship lessons will commence on Thursday  $1^{st}$  week of term and conclude on the Tuesday last week of term. Horses can be made available to hire and the experience levels of your rider will be catered for appropriately.

Monday lesson – Mrs Alicia Field – Eventing / Ms Anthea Sutherland - Dressage Tuesday lesson – Mr Jamie Murray – Showumping Thursday lesson – Ms Anthea Sutherland – Dressage/Showumping

Parents are welcome to attend Horsemanship lessons and help their children. However, it is essential that parents wear suitably tough and comfortable footwear.

Students may change in the kitchen at the Equestrian Centre or in their own float and then have a quick snack. Please encourage your child/children to leave the kitchen tidy if they are using this facility.

After saddling-up, students will meet in the sand arena and then start activities with their instructor at 4.00pm. **These activities may include taking the horses on local roads, especially for the cross country component of the lesson.** Riding will finish at approx. 5.30pm. At this time, students will unsaddle, cool down and rug their horses. Generally students will be ready to leave the Equestrian Centre by 6.00pm. However, it may be necessary to finish earlier over winter due to limited light.
