### Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C 23-24 August 2025

### The Narrow Gate—Luke 13: 22-30

Jesus is asked how many will be saved, but he avoids giving a numerical answer. Instead, he issues a warning: don't miss the chance to respond while it's still available. He uses everyday imagery to emphasize urgency, such as a narrow entrance crowded with people—suggesting that salvation requires effort and cannot be taken for granted.

He also paints a vivid picture of late-arriving travellers hoping for entry into a full lodging, only to be turned away despite knowing the owner. This illustrates the danger of assuming special treatment without timely action. Being unprepared or delaying our response to God's invitation can leave us outside, barred from the joy of the Kingdom.

Jesus invites everyone to the banquet of the Kingdom, but acceptance must come on God's terms, not ours. Entering through the "narrow gate" means shedding selfishness and embracing humility. Those who live by this message daily can trust in God's generosity, knowing His deepest desire is to welcome us as honoured guests into eternal life. ### **Second Reading** Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13 **A reading from the letter to the Hebrews**

Have you forgotten that encouraging text in which you are addressed as sons? My son, when the Lord corrects you, do not treat it lightly; but do not get discouraged when he reprimands you. For the Lord trains the ones that he loves and he punishes all those that he acknowledges as his sons. Suffering is part of your training; God is treating you as his sons. Has there ever been any son whose father did not train him? Of course, any punishment is most painful at the time, and far from pleasant; but later, in those on whom it has been used, it bears fruit in peace and goodness. So hold up your limp arms and steady your trembling knees and smooth out the path you tread; then the injured limb will not be wrenched, it will grow strong again.

# Gospel of Luke 13:22-30 A reading from the holy Gospel according to Luke

Through towns and villages Jesus went teaching, making his way to Jerusalem. Someone said to him,

'Sir, will there be only a few saved?'

He said to them,

'Try your best to enter by the narrow door, because, I tell you, many will try to enter and will not succeed.

'Once the master of the house has got up and locked the door, you may find yourself knocking on the door, saying, "Lord, open to us" but he will answer, "I do not know where you come from." Then you will find yourself saying, "We once ate and drank in your company; you taught in our streets" but he will reply, "I do not know where you come from. Away from me, all you wicked men!"

Then there will be weeping and grinding of teeth, when you see Abraham and Isaac and Jacob and all the prophets in the kingdom of God, and yourselves turned outside. And men from the east and west, from north and south, will come to take their places at the feast in the kingdom of God.
