INTRODUCTION

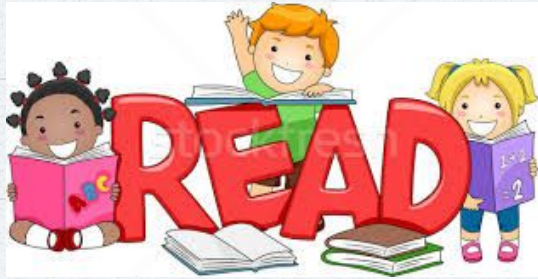


It has been a wonderful term filled with learning, laughter and memorable experiences. Our students have embraced every opportunity with enthusiasm and curiosity

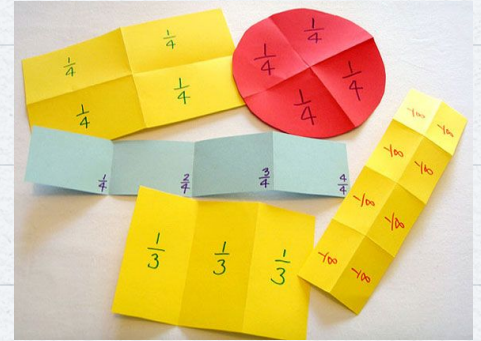
WRITING

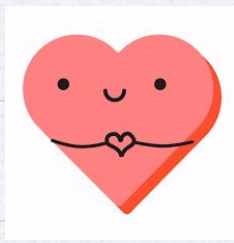
MATHS

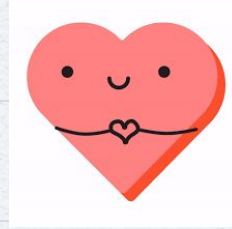
