

	HASS: Talk to your HASS teacher about your homework on Thursday the 6 th of March and record it in your diary.	Mathematics: Draw and name different fractions using words. Can you find, draw and label some fractions from around the house? Continue practising addition facts if you do not have automaticity with them yet.	Organisation: Unpack your own bag each night – rinse out food containers and refill water bottle. Have your diary signed each night. Plan for Fruity Friday – cut up some vegetables or fruit ready to share.
	Literacy: Read every night and have at least 3 books signed off on your PRC sheet. Talk with your parents about the books you are reading. Read at least a page out loud to your parents/grandparents/older sibling, etc. and get them to ask you questions about the sequence or order of events, using words such as first, next, last, after and afterwards. Then ask them some questions about sequence.	Design and Technology: Collect items for making your house (cardboard boxes and rolls, clear plastic, etc.)	German: Perform a puppet play for someone in German or play some games on the computer to practise your German.
	Be Active / Sports Practise hitting a ball with an implement (racquet, bat, stick, etc.) with some family members or friends. Do something active every day.	The Arts: Attend a performance or listen to some music.	Sharing the load: Do some jobs around the house or garden.
