

### BARKER COVID-19 SPORTS FIXTURES PROTOCOLS

The following protocols have been put in place to ensure the safety of all players, staff and spectators attending school sport at Barker.

## **Pre-Attendance Agreement**

Please do not attend Barker sports fixtures as either a player, staff or spectator if you:

- feel unwell or exhibit flu-like symptoms
- have been in contact with a known or suspected case of COVID-19
- are at a high health risk including the elderly and those with pre-existing conditions
- reside with clinically vulnerable individuals
- have recently visited Victoria and returned after the 7<sup>th</sup> July
- have recently visited various locations of identified COVID-19 clusters

#### **Attendance**

Only the following people will be permitted onsite:

- Players plus only **one** spectator (This will be strictly enforced)
- Coaches
- Faculty/Sport staff
- Match Officials
- Medical staff

Social distancing protocols must be followed while on site at all times.

### **Entry points**

Entry points will be restricted. Please refer to the attached Barker College map for the five access points:

- Rosewood Centre (Unwin Road)
- Aquatic Gates (College Crescent) GATE 3
- Tennis Courts Carpark (Clarke Road)
- Junior School Gates (Clarke Road)
- Mint Gates (Pacific Highway)

#### Registration and health checks

- All players, staff and spectators will be required to pass through a health screening point on arrival and to sanitise their hands
- On entry registration will be required to use a QR code for data collection should Covid contact tracing be required
- Please have a mobile device on hand for scanning the QR code
- For those unable to use a mobile device there will be hard copy registration sheet available





### **Facilities**

- The Rosewood Canteen and Marks Pavilion will be open for take away only. Strict guidelines will be in place and we ask that all visitors respect the safety measures that have been put in place.
- Toilets will be available and clearly marked
- Changerooms will be available for players only to 'get in/get out'. Players will not be permitted to meet or congregate inside.
- Shade tents will be available for team/coaches talks
- Water bubblers will be operational for filling of water bottles. No drinking directly from bubblers will be permitted
- Facilities will be cleaned throughout the day
- Good hygiene practices must be adhered too while using all facilities
- First aid will be available for Junior Teams on Phipps/Taylor Field. Additional first aid is available on the Rosewood Fields, at the Rosewood Centre and on the Main Oval.
- Barker has a no dogs policy

# **Player Information**

We ask that players please:

- arrive in playing uniform where possible to reduce time spent in changerooms
- bring and use their own hand sanitiser
- bring their own clearly marked drink bottle no sharing permitted, and their own food where possible
- DO NOT SPIT under any circumstances

Upon the completion of the sports fixture we ask that players, staff and spectators adhere to social distancing practices and move offsite immediately. Spectators and players are only permitted on site for the game that the student is playing, or the game after if the student is needed as a reserve.
