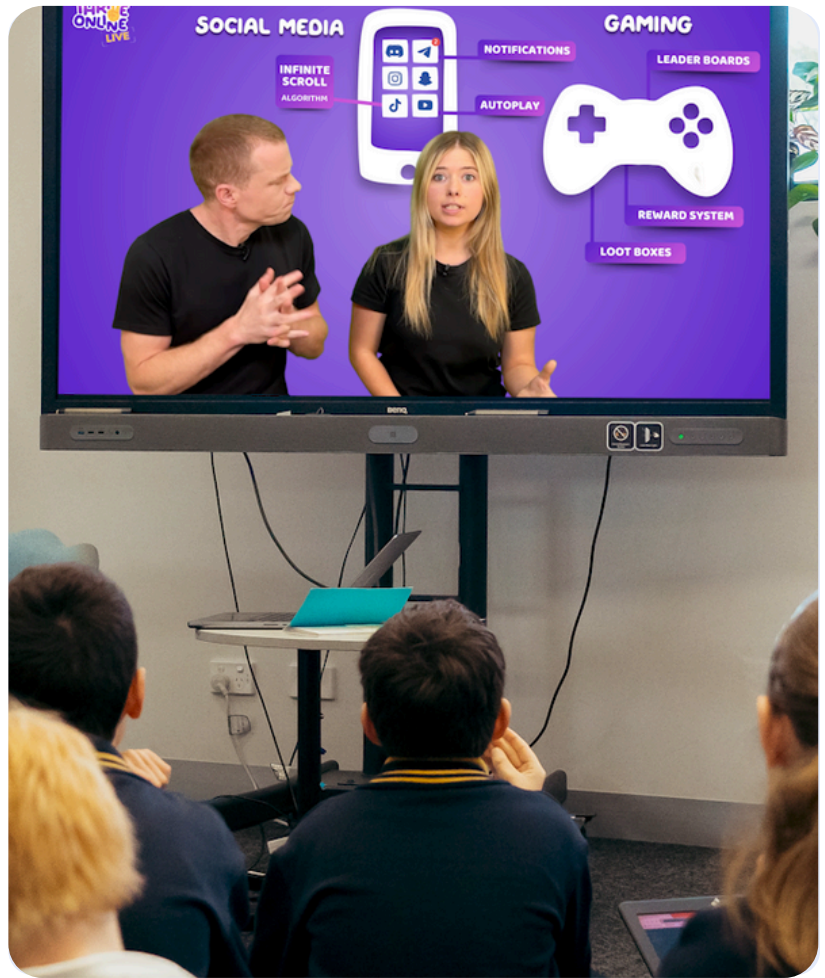


Here's what we covered:
