



Bond University Scholarship Application Process for High School Leavers

The following outlines the simple steps to applying for a scholarship for students currently studying Year 12 at an Australian High School.

1 COMPLETE THE BOND UNIVERSITY STUDY APPLICATION FORM AT [APPLY.BOND.EDU.AU](https://apply.bond.edu.au).

- Before commencing a scholarship application, you are required to complete a Bond University Study Application Form. This is your application to study at Bond and will identify the program you are wishing to study at Bond.
- You can log-in and out of the application form at any time using your email address and chosen password.
- You will be asked to upload copies of your full Year 11 school reports and Semester 1 Year 12 school reports.
- Your Bond University representative will be in contact to discuss your application within 4 weeks of submission date. Please expect them to call to arrange a time convenient to you.

2 COMPLETE THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM AT [APPLY.BOND.EDU.AU/SCHOLARSHIPS](https://apply.bond.edu.au/scholarships).

- **IMPORTANT** - You will not be able to commence the Scholarship Application Form until you have fully submitted your Bond University Study Application Form.
- You will be required to use the same log-in email and password as you used for your Bond University Study Application Form.
- Check the scholarship requirements for documents you will need to complete your scholarship application form. You will also need to provide a school reference, so please have your Career Advisor's details ready. Each scholarship will have a closing date so you must ensure that you submit your application before this date.
- Once you log into the Scholarship Application Form, the summary page will list all the scholarships that are currently open for applications.

• ALWAYS CHECK:

- The eligibility requirements of each scholarship before choosing which scholarships you wish to apply for, as changes cannot be made once you have submitted your scholarship application.
- The closing dates of each scholarship you are applying for as we will not accept any late applications.
- Once you have submitted your Scholarship Application Form you cannot return to apply for further scholarships, so please apply for all chosen scholarships within the one scholarship application by the earliest required closing date.

3 KEEP AN EYE ON YOUR EMAIL FOR FURTHER SELECTION REQUIREMENTS.

- All Bond scholarships follow vigorous selection processes which are outlined at bond.edu.au/scholarships on the relevant scholarship webpages.
- Some scholarships require further documents or applicant input at later stages in the selection process. This will be communicated to you via the email address that you have provided to us. Please keep an eye out for emails from us regarding your scholarship application.
- Students who progress to further selection stages will be provided with all relevant information and deadline dates as required.

FAQ's for High School Leavers applying for a scholarship

AM I ABLE TO APPLY FOR MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP?

Yes, we encourage you to apply for as many scholarships you feel you are eligible for. This should all be done in the one Scholarship Application Form.

I AM APPLYING FOR TWO SCHOLARSHIPS THAT HAVE DIFFERENT APPLICATION CLOSING DATES, CAN I SUBMIT ONE NOW AND THEN RETURN TO MY APPLICATION AND APPLY FOR THE OTHER AT A LATER DATE?

No, once you have submitted your Scholarship Application Form you are unable to make changes or apply for further scholarships. It is important that you apply and submit your scholarship application form by the earliest scholarship closing date, and include all required documents by this date.

I AM TRYING TO START A SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM, HOWEVER IT WON'T LET ME LOG-IN.

You can only access the Scholarship Application Form once you have fully submitted your Bond University Study Application Form. If you can't access the scholarship application form, log back into your study application to check you have submitted successfully. CAN I APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP TO COMMENCE AT BOND UNIVERSITY IN THE MAY OR SEPTEMBER SEMESTER?

Scholarship recipients must commence their studies in the January semester. In order to be eligible to be shortlisted for a scholarship, students must choose the January semester as their first preference on their study application. If you have already completed your study application with either the May or September semester as your commencement, please contact one of our Future Student Advisors on 1800 074 074 who can amend your starting semester to January.

I'VE MISSED THE SCHOLARSHIP DEADLINE, WILL YOU ACCEPT MY LATE APPLICATION?

No, the scholarship deadlines are strict deadlines and no late applications will be accepted.

MY FRIEND HAS RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM THEIR BOND UNIVERSITY REPRESENTATIVE TO MEET FOR AN INTERVIEW, AND I HAVEN'T HAD A CALL YET, DOES THIS MEAN I HAVEN'T BEEN SHORTLISTED FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

No, the interviews/meeting with Bond are to discuss your study application in more detail and answer questions you may have on studying at Bond, it is not with regards to scholarship applications. Scholarship shortlisting is done via other processes, as outlined on the website.
