# Term Three Week 7 & 8 Foundation Learning Intentions

For the Children to:

#### Emotional:

\*Share how they are feeling using emojis during a positive primer check.

#### Social:

\*Show respect using whole body listening, and refrain from speaking over others.

\*Engage in dramatic dialogue in play or roleplaying contexts.

### Language:

\* Repeat and practise Italian phrases and gestures: Poui ripetere, piano/veloce

\* Incidental vocab: si, no, fantastisco, tutti, perche, oggi, cerchio

\*Perform plays and puppet shows that involve speaking as a character.

\*Adjust speaking volume for different contexts.

## Cognitive:

\* Form clear questions to get information.

\*Identify leaders in the community.

\*Describe leadership qualities and explain how we can all be leaders.

### Physical:

- \* Sit attentively in front of the screen during Zoom sessions.
  - \*Use the reaction button appropriately.

Literacy:

- \* Practise the digraph/er/as in 'teacher' (Week 7).
- \*Identify the new common words: which, them (Week 7).
- \*Practise the digraph /th/ as in 'feather' (Week 8).
- \*Identify the new common word: there, other (Week 8).
- \*Express opinions about facts or information learned.
- \*Celebrate Book Week (Old Worlds, New Worlds, Other Worlds).
- \*Express why an author might choose to write a story or write about a topic.
- \*Recognise and use adjectives that describe what something is like.
- \*Write to inform the audience and also to engage or interest others.

Numeracy:

- \*Organise answers to yes/no questions into simple data displays using objects and drawings.
- \*Interpret simple data displays about yes/no questions.
- \*Practise tallying numbers.
- \*Practise doubling numbers.

Religion:

- \* Identify leaders in biblical stories eg: Moses. David (David & Goliath). John the Baptist and Jesus.
- \* Explain why biblical figures in the Old Testament were chosen as leaders.
