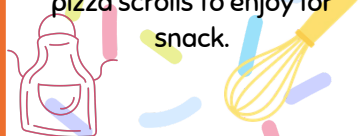

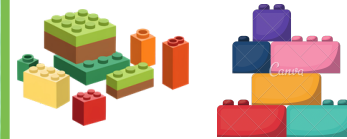

What to bring to Imagination

- Children must bring their own recess and lunch. Imagination provides afternoon tea
- Drink bottle
- Hat
- Electronics including iPads and iPhones are not permitted at Imagination, unless specified
- Please leave toys, trading cards or personal items at home. We are not responsible for any lost or broken items
- Spending money is not permitted on excursions
- If your child requires their own sensitive sunscreen

Clothing

- Children must wear appropriate sun safe clothing which covers their shoulders
- Ensure that your child is wearing enclosed shoes
- Label all clothing with your child's name, as we gain a lot of lost property in the school holidays
- Please ensure that your child brings a labelled spare change of clothes, underwear, and socks

Excursions

- Please be at OSHC no later than 8:30am to ensure that your child is prepared for the excursion
