- 3. Identification of initiative funding options
- 4. Act as a sounding board to the Parish Priest, Richard Jacques and his team and provide commercial and insightful feedback on ideas and initiatives including parish related advice, support and services covering improvements and issue resolution
- 5. Reduce Richard's workload by assisting with commercial elements of the school's administration (ie commercial contract assessments, supplier identification, price comparison and recommendation provision)
- 6. Champion and execute selected initiatives.
