PRINCIPAL NOTIFIES SCHOOL COMMUNITY

Teachers notified of impending closure/relocation.



Templestowe Heights Primary notified of required space for relocation. Message to all families sent via the Compass portal to inform of dates and relocation address.

Families *must* respond to the message so the school can log the message has been received. If no response is received by 7pm the night before, school staff will call directly as a secondary measure.
