Dear Parents/Carers and students,

Year 2-6 Britton Shield Swimming Carnival

On Friday 4 March 2022, the College is hosting the Britton Shield Swim Carnival at Clayfield College pool. The carnival is the first Britton Shield activity of the year. All boys in Years 2-6 are expected to attend; however, if your child will be absent for any reason the usual expectations around communicating student absences apply. The carnival commences at 8:40am and concludes at approximately 12:30pm.

Transport:

- Students are to attend their regular class for roll call at 8:30am. They will meet Mrs Corness at the Amphitheatre who will walk with the boys to the swimming pool.

Uniform:

- All students arrive at school wearing their sports uniform (blue house shirt and PE shorts, white socks, sports shoes and hat) with their jammers worn underneath.
- Boys jammers (plain black) and College swim shirt are to be worn, with sunscreen to be reapplied frequently across the day. **All boys competing in Britton Shield Swimming are required to wear jammers. Please refer to *The Collective – Primary News / Uniform Notice – PP-6 Boys Jammers*.**
- Please note that coloured paper and hair colour, both of which can affect the pool's filter and cleaning system, are not permitted.

What to Bring:

- Clayfield College sports bag
- Clayfield College swim shirt / cap/goggles
- Towel
- Clayfield College tracksuit top (if needed)
- Slides
- Underclothes for after the carnival
- Morning Tea & Lunch or available for purchase \$5 food pack (incl. sausage sizzle, popper, sml chips/popcorn and Zooper Dooper)

Unfortunately, due to COVID regulations there are to be no spectators. Please ensure you have checked your son for any COVID symptoms the morning of the event. Any student showing COVID symptoms should refrain from attending the event.

Should the carnival need to be postponed for any reason, a message will go out on the College App by 6:30am on the morning of the carnival.
