Career Focus

Careers Advisor

For many careers advisors in schools, their role (sometimes unwantedly) is thrust upon them. Fortunately, because the role is such a great one, they soon fall in love with it.

Being a Careers Advisor at a school is only the tip of the career-in-careers ice-berg. It is a massive industry. Notwithstanding Human Resources in larger organisations who handle their recruitment, I counted 16 employment agencies in Shepparton alone! It is a virtual web of career-o-topia!

Getting back to the good old Careers Advisor at your school, who is normally your first serious contact with the career world - they must have a qualification to be able to tell you where to go. (Well technically, they have to let YOU decide where to go.) A teaching degree is simply not enough; they have to study something similar to a Cert IV in Career Development or a Graduate Certificate (or Grad Diploma) in Career Development. So your Careers Advisor is severely weighted in career knowhow!

You don't **have** to be a teacher to be a Careers Advisor; many schools employ non-teaching staff (with Career qualifications) to deliver their career program. Many advisors start in the role first, then undertake the training (which is mandatory) as they go.

If you like to help people and enjoy making a difference to them, then perhaps a Careers Advising role (in some form) is a good choice for you?
