EFA Eligibility:

“Shepparton High School Education Funding Allowance is available to all students whose families hold a current and valid Health Care Card or Pension concession card, or for Foster families. This assistance will be provided for all students up to the age of 16. All registrations for the program will close on 28th February in the relevant school year. ” Parents must present their health care card to the Finance Department by this date.

Payment Amount:

“That \$250 per eligible student be allocated to the students account under the EFA program for 2015, which is to be allocated on a \$ for \$ basis.” Each amount paid by the parent up to the value of \$250.00 in total will be matched by the school.

For students who turn 16 during the year a pro-rata payment will be calculated on the number of months up to and including the month of their birthday.
