



COVID-19 Information for Schools

Spectators

- Only one parent per child is permitted as spectators and need to have downloaded the CovidSafe App
- No seating in the grandstand at Queens Park
- All spectators will need to register their attendance via the QR Code at our venues
- No other spectators will be permitted at any venue including old boys, siblings, other family members and current students
- A canteen at Queens Park will be in operation with pre-packaged food only, however, there will be no BBQ
- All spectators need to maintain social distancing at all times
- Any player, staff or spectator who is ill is NOT permitted to attend any venue
- Any player, staff or spectator who has returned from overseas or visited
 Victoria in the past 14 days is NOT permitted to attend any venue
- Ensure processes are in place to exclude participants (including spectators and officials) if they have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website (nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latestnews-and-updates).
- Take all reasonable steps to minimise the number of spectators attending
- All PA announcements need to be adhered to
- Supplied hand sanitiser needs to be regularly applied
- Only players and appointed first aid staff are permitted in the First Aid Room

Players

- No changeroom facilities will be in use
- All players will need to arrive ready to play and depart immediately at the conclusion of their game
- Both NSW Police and Security will be in attendance to ensure protocols are adhered to
- All spectators need to maintain social distancing of 1.5m at all times as per signage at the venue
- Any player, staff or spectator who is ill is NOT permitted to attend any venue
- Any player, staff or spectator who has returned from overseas or visited Victoria in the past 14 days is NOT permitted to attend any venue
- Ensure processes are in place to exclude participants (including spectators and officials) if they have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website (nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latestnews-and-updates).
- All players must have their own clearly labelled drink bottles and no sharing is permitted
- There will be no after-match functions for any 1sts teams

Staff, Coaches, Officials, First Aiders

- All visiting team lists with appointed coaches will need to be sent prior to Saturday
- Any player, staff or spectator who is ill is NOT permitted to attend any venue
- Any player, staff or spectator who has returned from overseas or visited
 Victoria in the past 14 days is NOT permitted to attend any venue
- Ensure processes are in place to exclude participants (including spectators and officials) if they have attended any of the reported case locations listed on the NSW Health website (nsw.gov.au/covid-19/latestnews-and-updates).
- Players and coaches must bring their own necessary equipment and this equipment is not to be shared.
- All equipment is to be disinfected after use
