Netball Victoria (**NV**) and its Affiliates are committed to the health and wellbeing of all of its members and others who participate in NV's activities. NV wants netball to be fun, enjoyable and safe for all involved and is dedicated to providing a safe environment for everyone.

As part of that dedication to health and wellbeing, NV is committed to ensuring the safety of all of its members, particularly Children and Young People.

Those participating in Netball Victoria activities coaches, officials and referees must have a WWCC before submitting a team.

Failure to comply with this Policy may result in disciplinary action in accordance with this Policy and/or other NV regulations.

** First round is also a registration day so arrive 20 – 30 mins before game time and hand in forms.

Becoming an Umpire, Coach, Team Coach or Team Meeting Representative is a very valuable way to support your children in their netball endeavours. Coaching and Umpiring Clinics ran by Netball Victoria are on offer during the year.

This year teams need a Team Coach and a Team Meeting Representative. The Team Coach is in charge of letting HNA – Junior of any team changes, filling out score cards with all players' names and to be the contact person for late forfeits etc.
