What are the main roles and responsibilities for each leader?



What do I need to do if I would like to be a school leader?

All interested students need to fill out the expression of interest form on the following page. Identify the position that interests you, and have your parents sign the form. Return this form to your class teacher by **Monday, 8th of February**. Both Sports Leaders and SWPBL students will need to prepare a short speech.

Do I need to deliver a speech?

Both Sports and SWPBL Leaders require you to deliver a short speech identifying your strengths and reasons why people should elect you. Both will be delivered next **Wednesday, 10th of February**, Health & PE Leader in front of your house team with the Year 3-6 cohort present and the SWPBL position will be in front of the 5-6 cohort.
