#### Year 6 Scholarship Concert Band Program

Dear Parents.

I am writing to you to introduce our 2026 Year 6 Scholarship Concert Band Program.

All students in year 6 who are not already involved in the string program will have the opportunity to learn a brass or woodwind instrument. A small number may also be able to learn percussion. While parents and students will have some input into the selection of an instrument, allocation of an instrument will be based on physical suitability and the required number of each instrument necessary to run a successful band program. With this in mind, we aim to have the following numbers playing a woodwind or brass instrument in year 6.

By keeping as close as we can to these numbers of instruments, we will have a balanced year 6 band that can at least play simple pieces by semester 2 of year 6 and will follow on straight into the year 7 band in 2027.

Lessons: Boys will have a weekly lesson in pairs and will attend a weekly band rehearsal commencing on Tuesday morning in Term 1, Week 5. The rehearsal is compulsory and will be before school at 7.20am in the Basile Studio, first floor of the Cultural Centre.

**Costs**: The College has been very generous in funding this program. The normal cost for a year of shared lessons is \$780.00 per student. With College support this cost has been discounted. An itemised amount of \$465.00 will therefore appear on your school fee statement for the beginning of 2026.

For the vast majority who undertake the year's tuition this effectively means the first semester of tuition is free to parents. If a boy is struggling in this program, he may be withdrawn at the end of Semester 1 at no cost to the parents. The \$465.00 will be credited to your school fees.

For the band program, selecting an instrument will take the following process.

- Monday 10 November 3:30pm 5:00pm: 'Have A Go' instrumental afternoon.

  This is an opportunity for the boys to try several instruments with the instrumental tutors.

  The format for the afternoon is:
  - 3:30pm 4:00pm Information and demonstration session for parents and students. Please meet in the Mary Kerr upstairs 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the Cultural Centre.
  - 4:00pm 5:00pm students try instruments and hand in preference forms.
- The Performing Arts Department will then allocate instruments to students based on student preference and tutor recommendations. This information will be sent to Parents.
- Term 1, Week 2, 2026: Instruments and Practice Record Books will be distributed to students at their first lesson.

There is an expectation that the boys will do the required minimum practice to progress on their allocated instrument as this is a scholarship program, attendance at Band is compulsory. This is an exciting first step into the T.C band program, one that will be a great success with your support.

#### Other Year 6 Instrumental Music Enrolment Options

Tuition should be undertaken for the entire academic year. Full annual tuition and hire fees are payable for withdrawals after Week 5 of Term 1 (Lesson 4).

#### **Bagpipe Tuition**

Bagpipe Tuition is available from Year 6.

Bagpipe lessons are shared 30-minute lessons and cost \$780.00 per year.

All students learning Bagpipes will be charged a hire and maintenance fee of \$385.00 per year.

#### Tryouts for the bagpipes will be held on Monday 10 November, 4:00pm – 5:00pm.

All students that attend the Band Program information session will also get the opportunity to trial the bagpipes for our Pipes and Drums Program.

### Piano Tuition

Piano Tuition is available in Year 6.

Piano lessons are 40 Minute individual lessons at a cost of \$2,090.00 per year.

#### **Vocal Tuition**

Vocal Tuition is available from Year 6.

Vocal lessons are 30 Minute individual lessons at a cost of \$1,565.00 per year.

# **CONDITIONS OF TUITION**

#### YEAR 6 CONCERT BAND PROGRAM

There can be no withdrawals after Semester Two has commenced.

Membership of a Trinity College Instrumental Ensemble becomes automatic when students reach the appropriate standard.

If a student is unable to attend a lesson, he must inform the instrumental teacher prior to the day of his lesson to allow another lesson to be arranged. Due to the nature of the school's computerised attendance records, lessons cannot be changed on the day. If insufficient notice is given, **the lesson may not be rescheduled**.

Accurate records of practice and lesson attendance will be kept in the student Practice Record Book which must be brought, duly signed by parents, to all instrumental lessons. Practice Record books are provided by the College and given to the students at their first lesson.

All instruments hired from the College become the student's responsibility. Students need to take all due care to maintain the instrument. Any negligent damage will be charged to the parents.
