Introduction

On the 20th of March 2019, every student, parent and staff were emailed a link to a survey regarding a proposed new College Blazer. The survey closed at 4.00pm on Monday 1 April 2019.

The P&F Association proposed a change in uniform starting in 2020 for the senior school blazer. Any change would be phased in over two years if the survey was highly in favour of the proposal.

The proposed blazer, including material and colour, were chosen by the P&F Association during a series of meetings preceding the survey. The uniform samples were created and reviewed by members of the P&F Association as well as staff across the College.

There was a mannequin modelling the proposed blazer in the College foyer. Parents, Staff and Students were invited to view samples and to leave feedback and general comments in the survey.

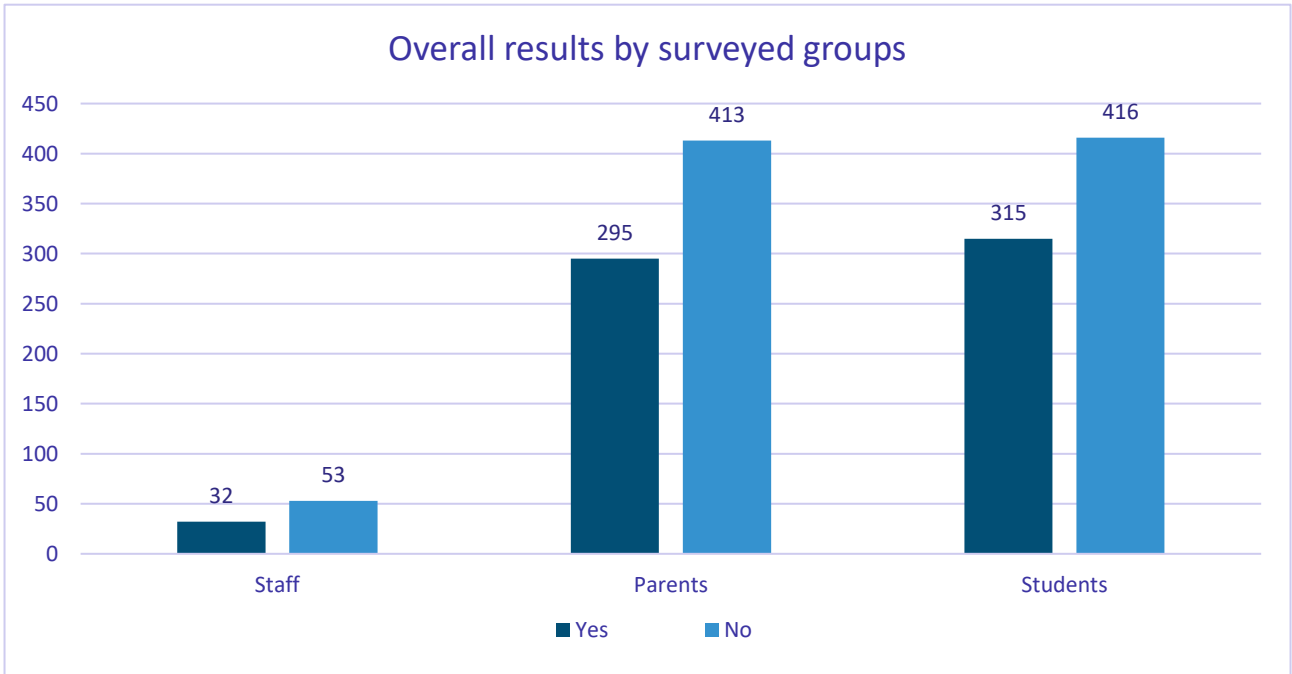
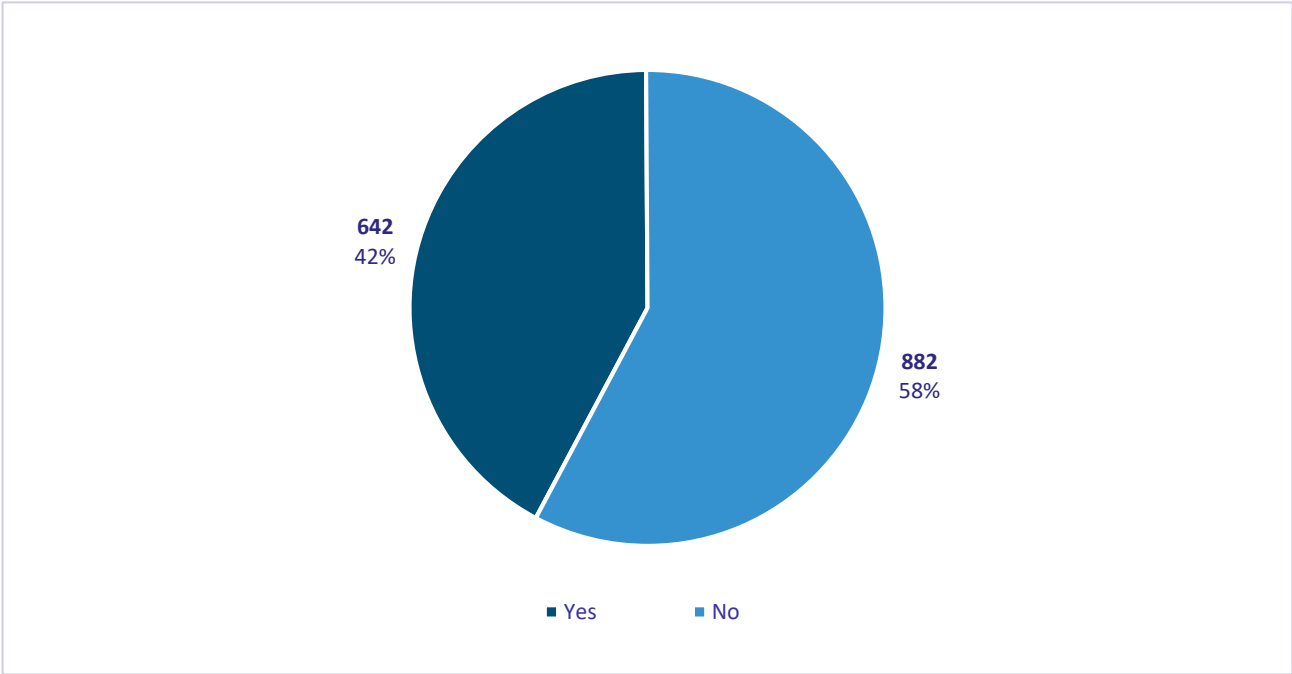
The questions in the survey included the following:

Question 1: Are you in favour of the introduction of a senior (Year 11 and 12) blazer?

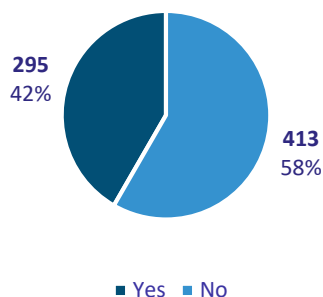

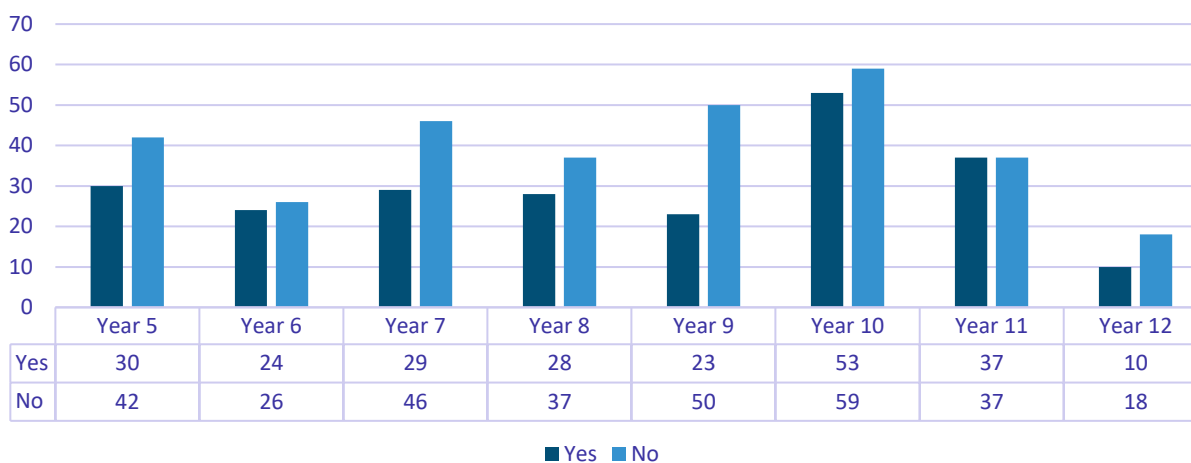
Are you in favour of the introduction of a senior (Year 11 and 12) blazer?

Overall parent results

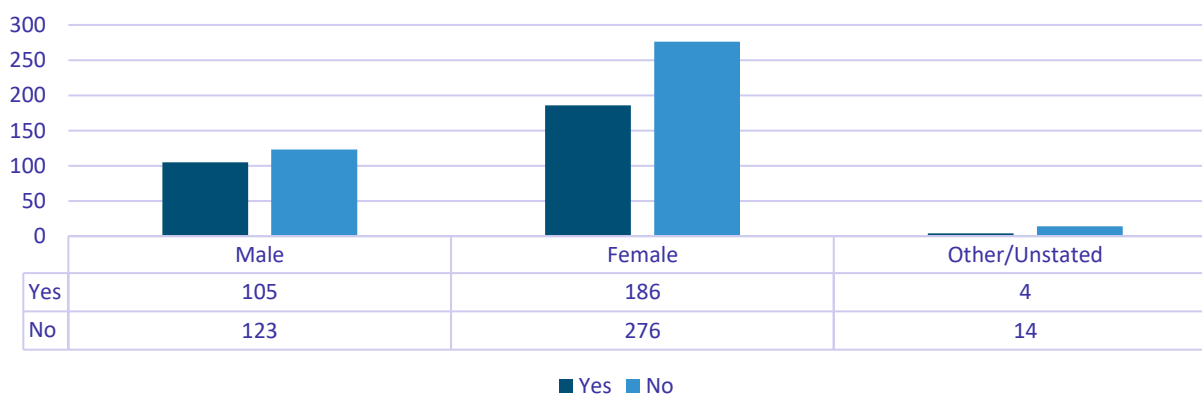

Parent results by year group

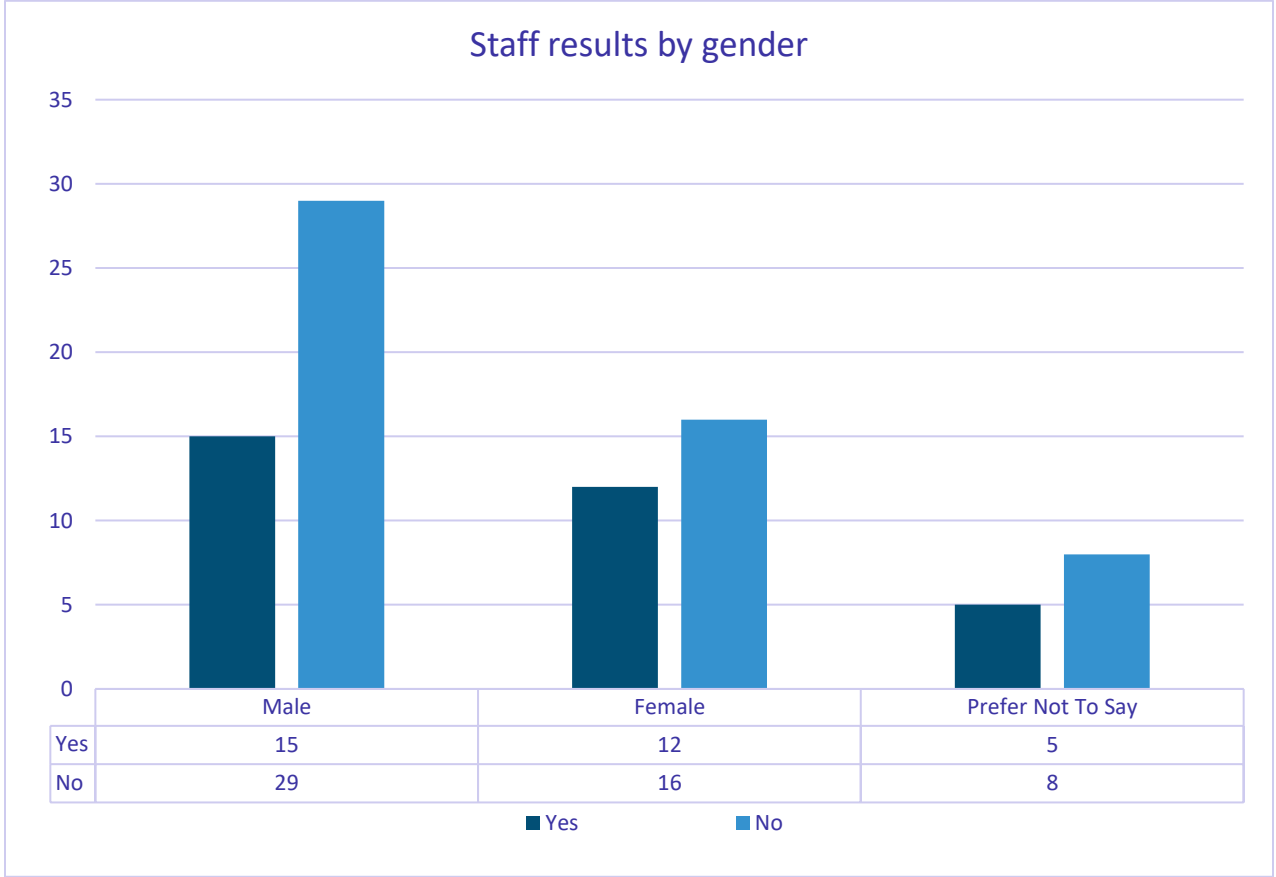
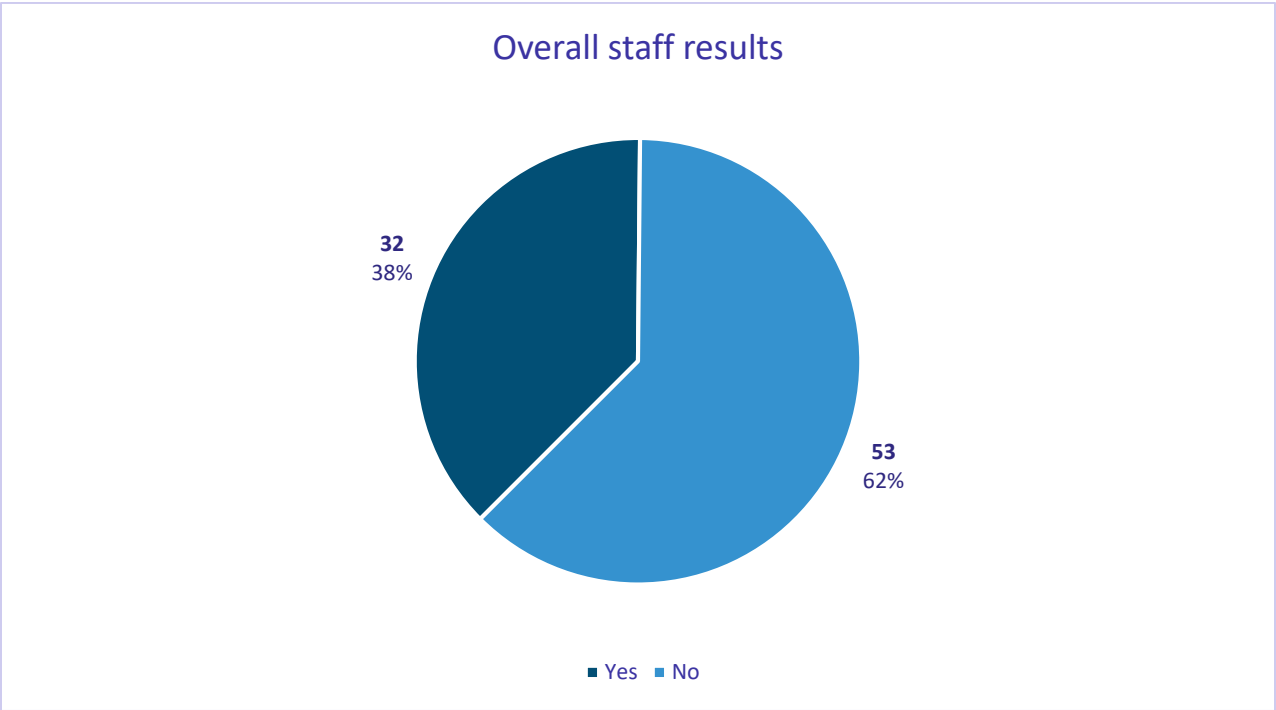


Parent results by gender



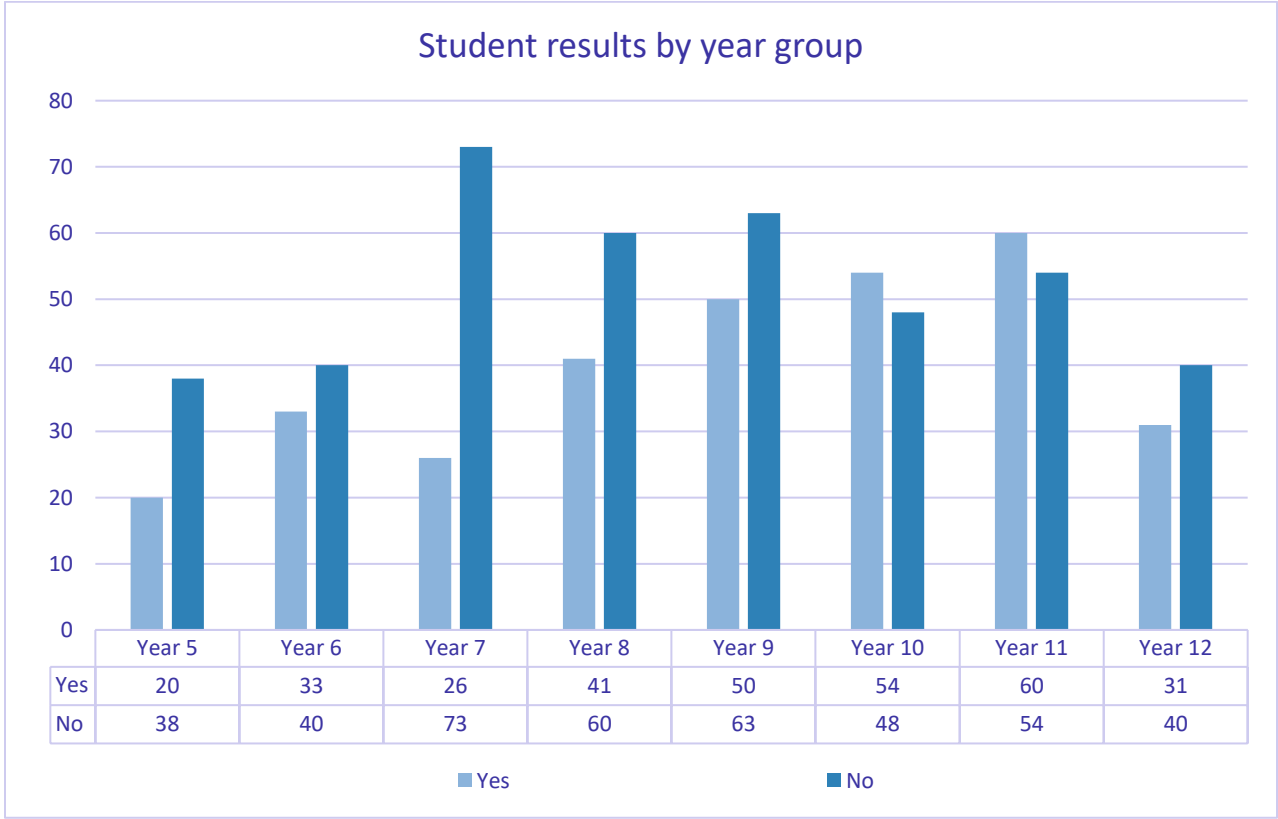
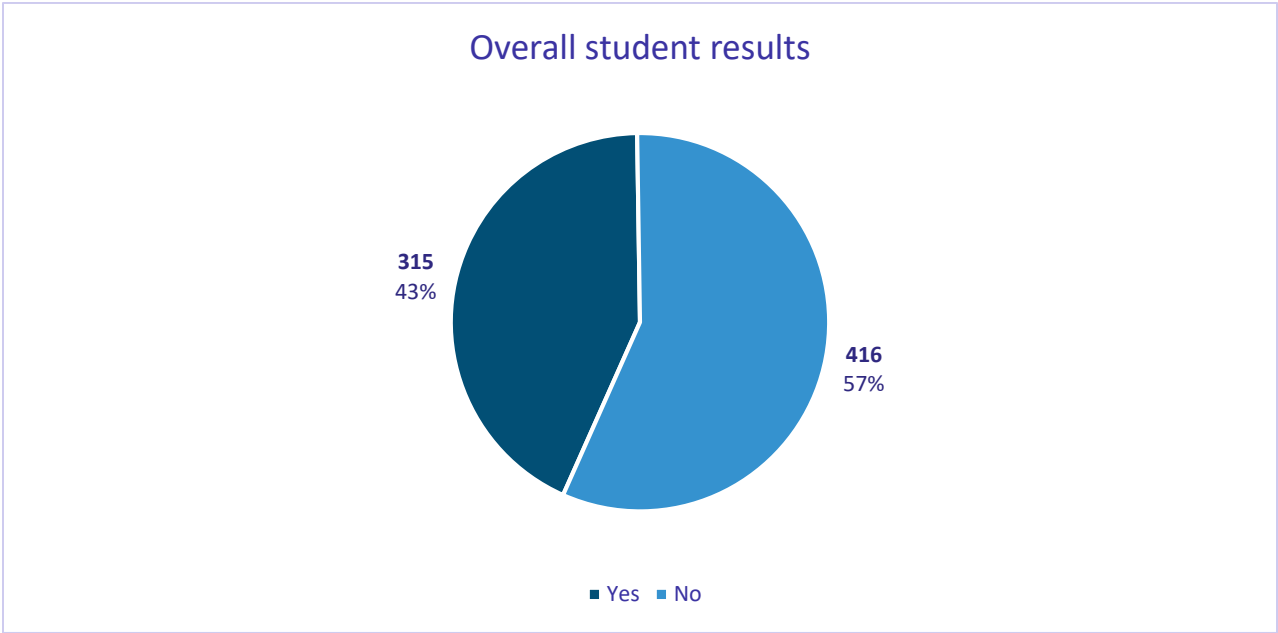

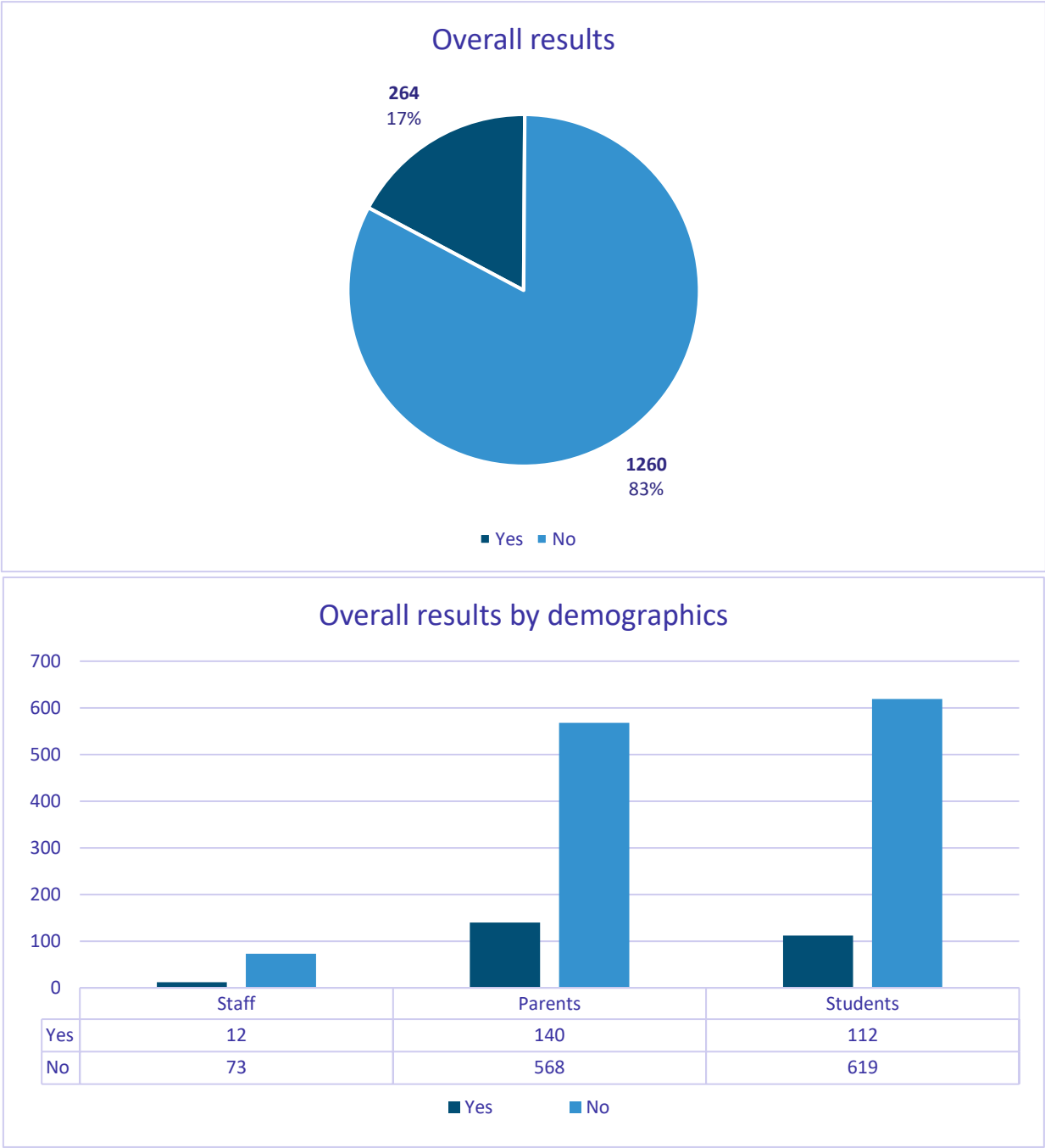

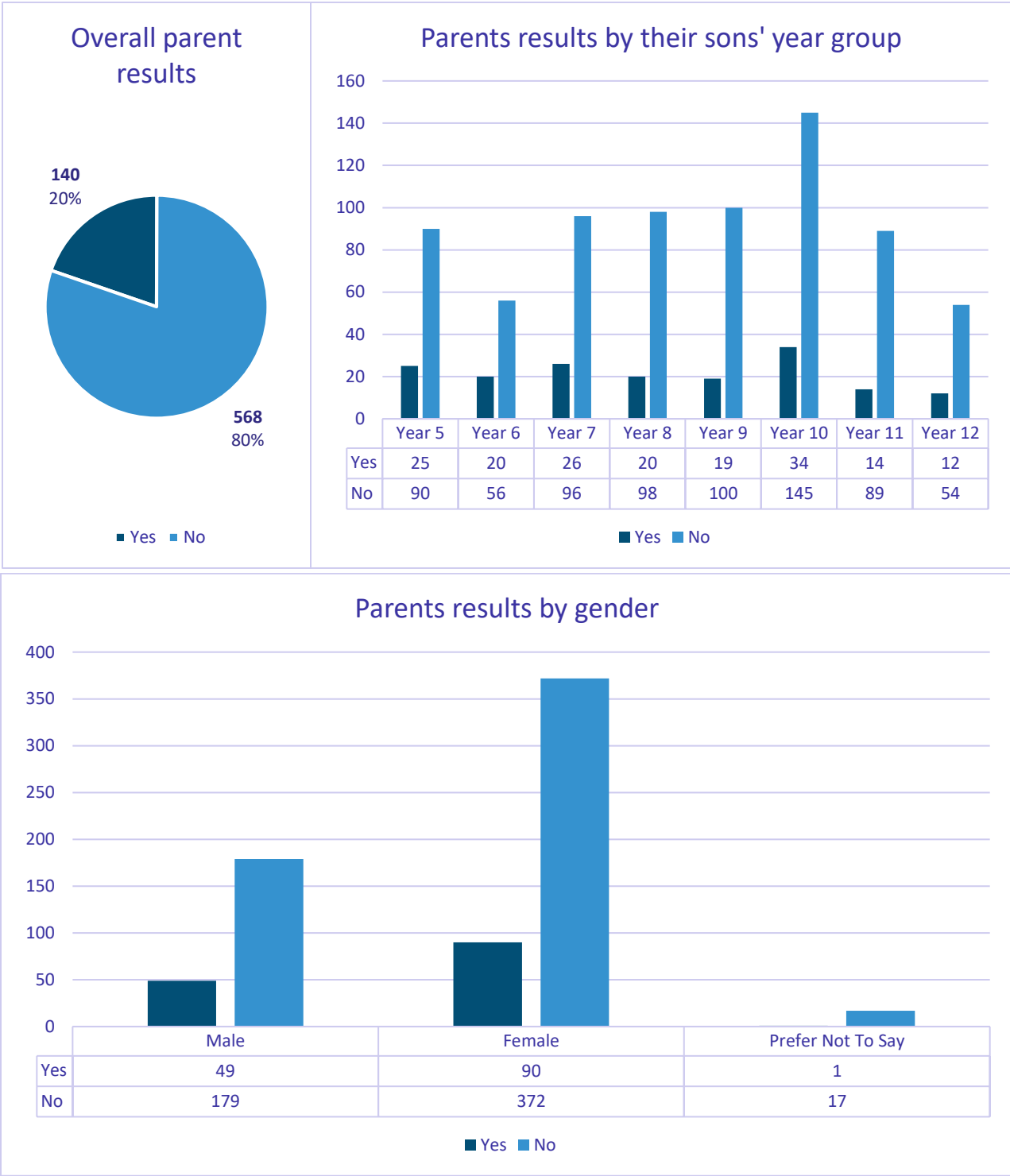

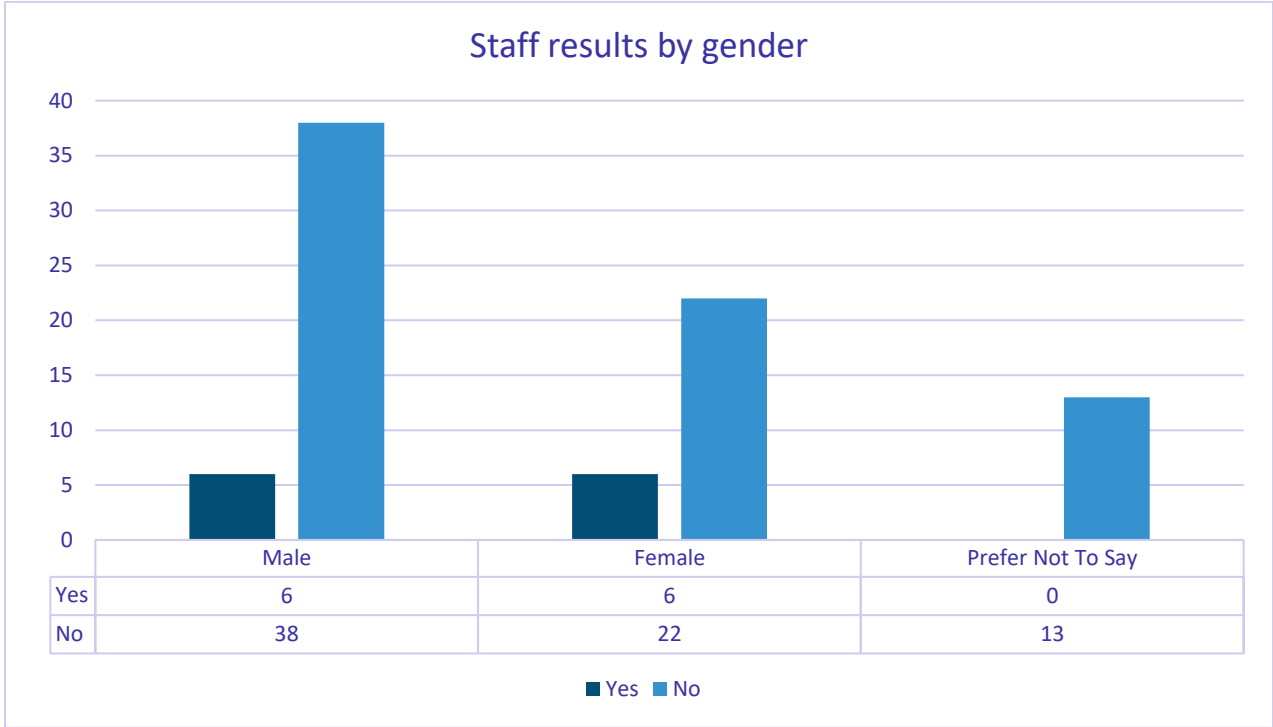
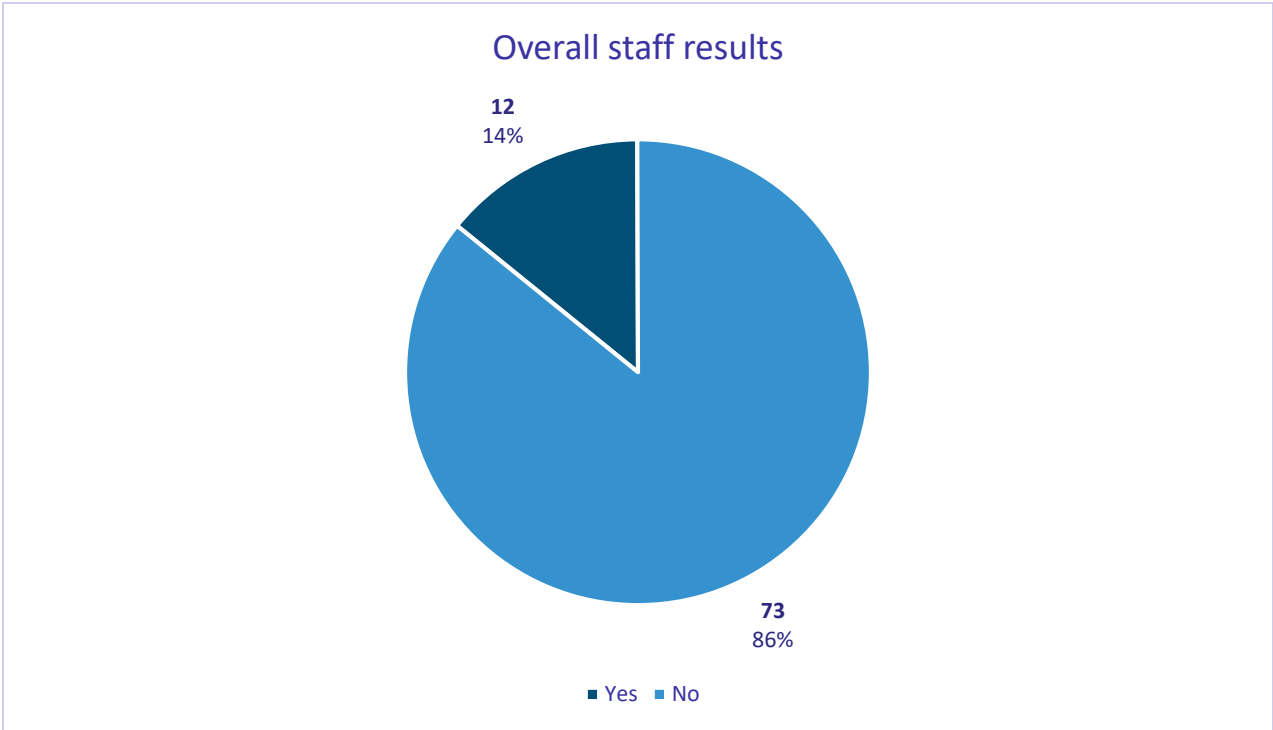

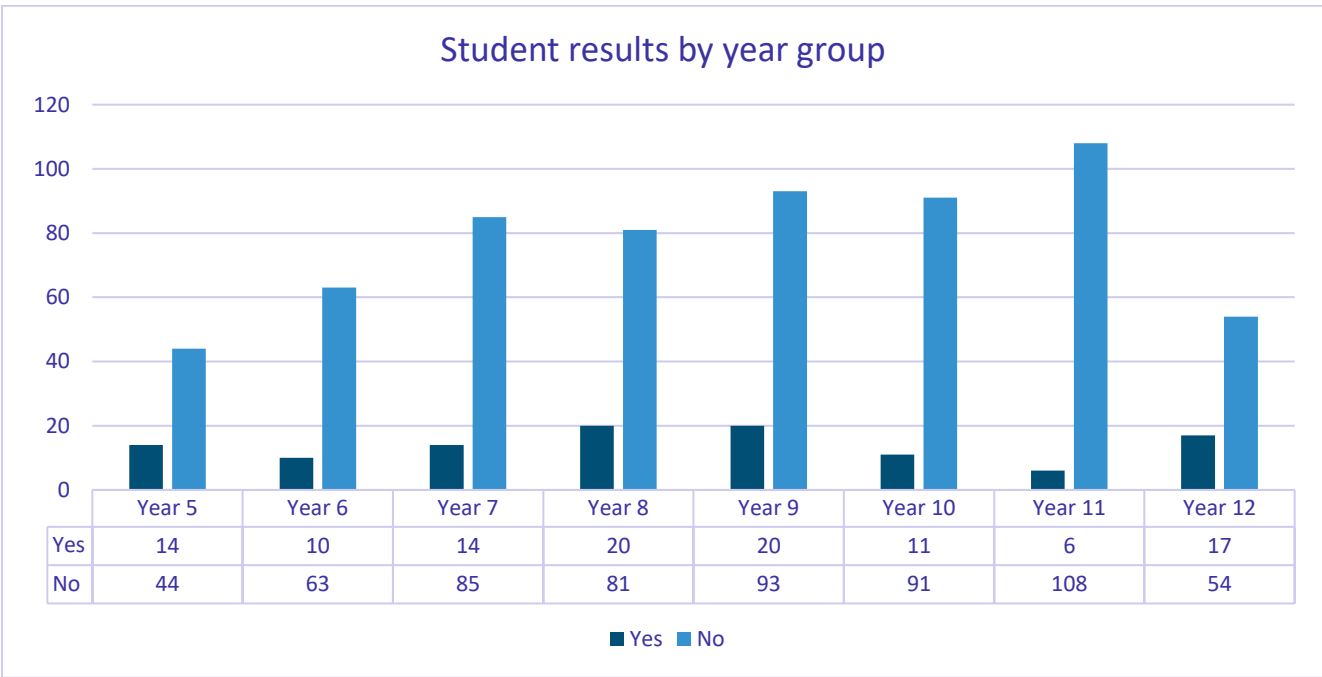
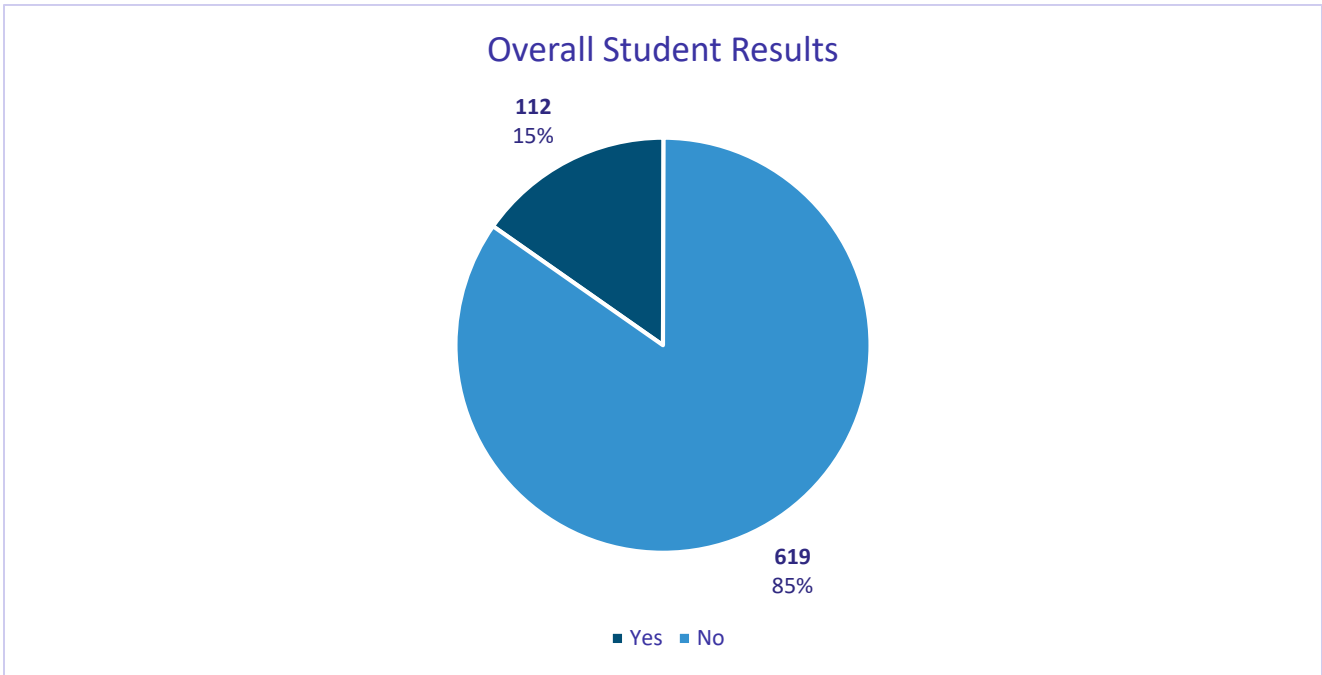

Would you prefer the blazer to be for all year groups?



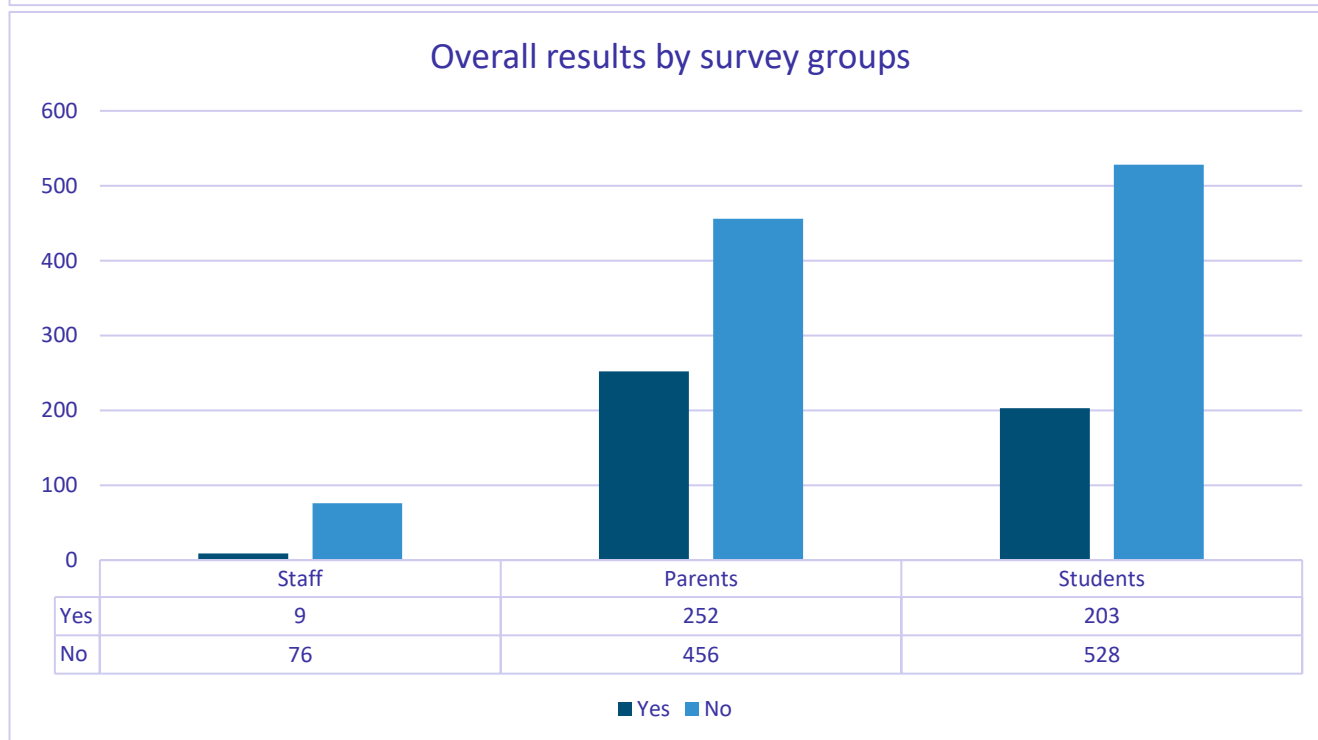
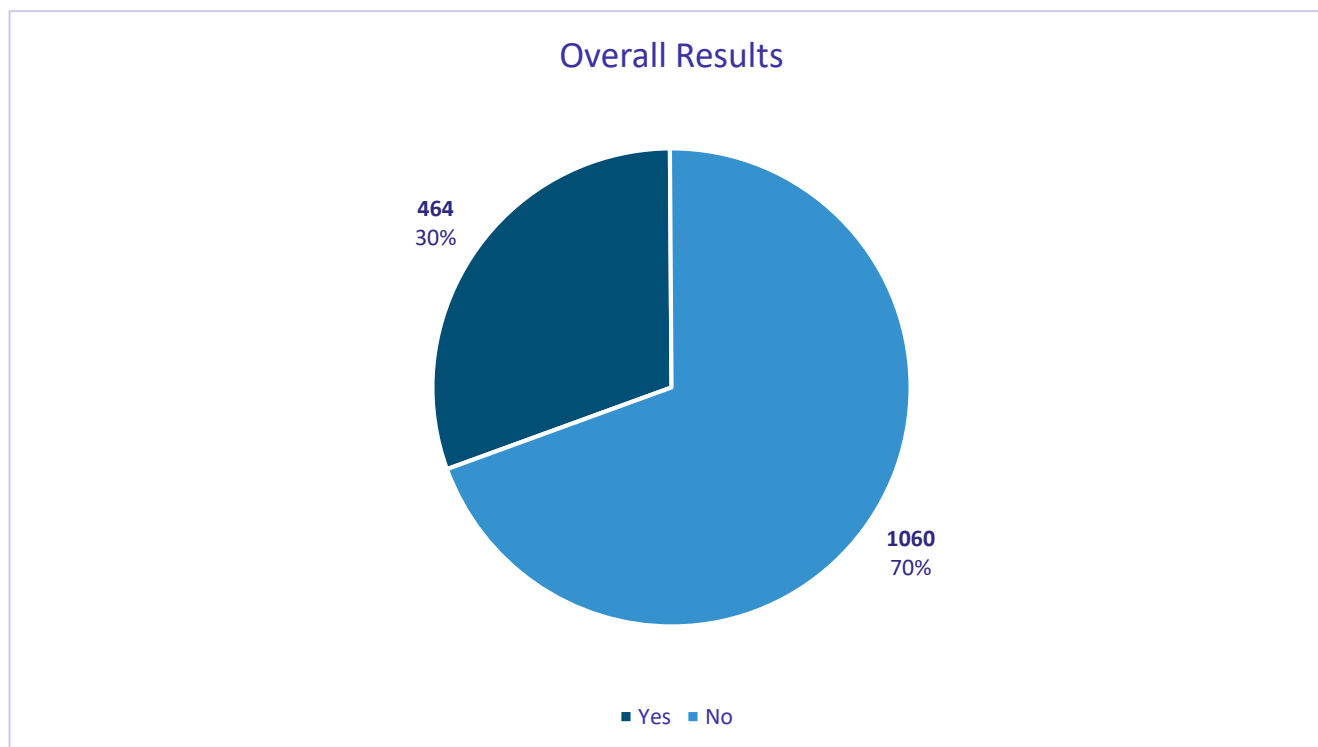

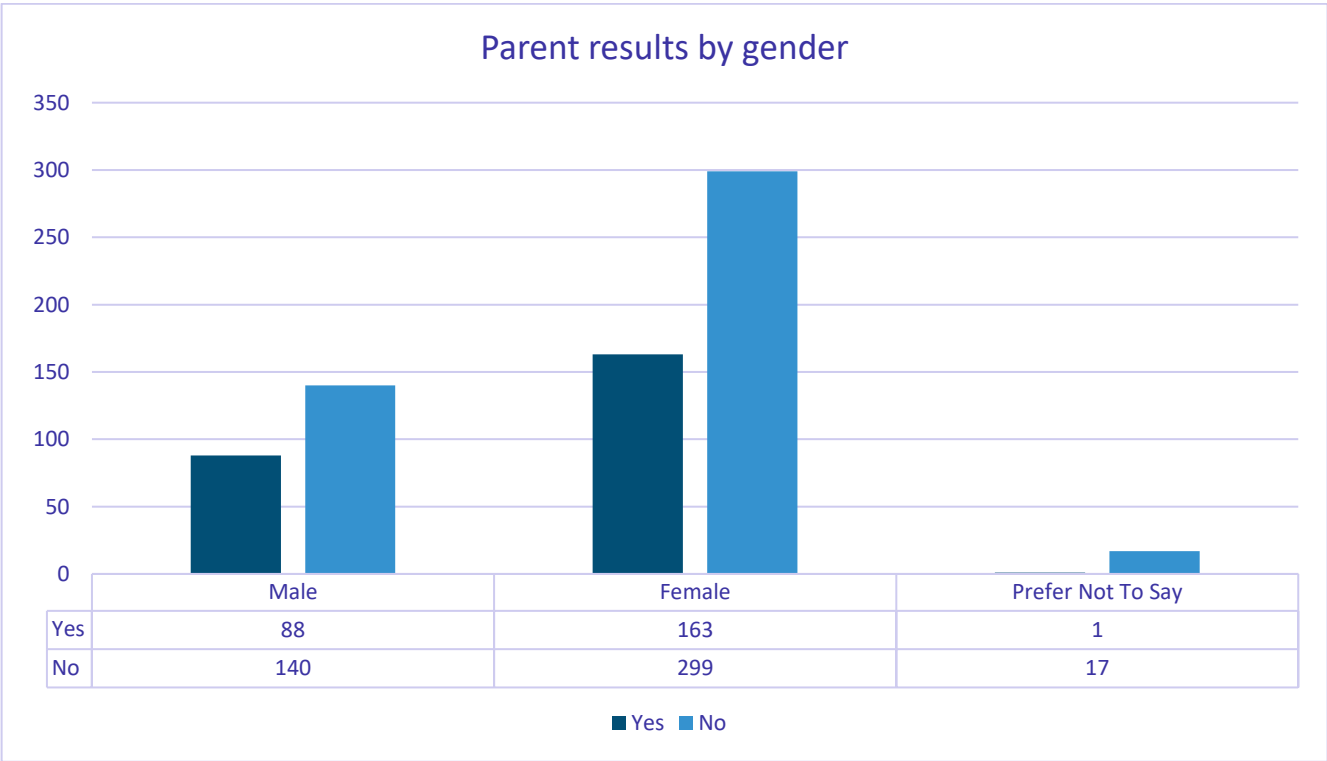
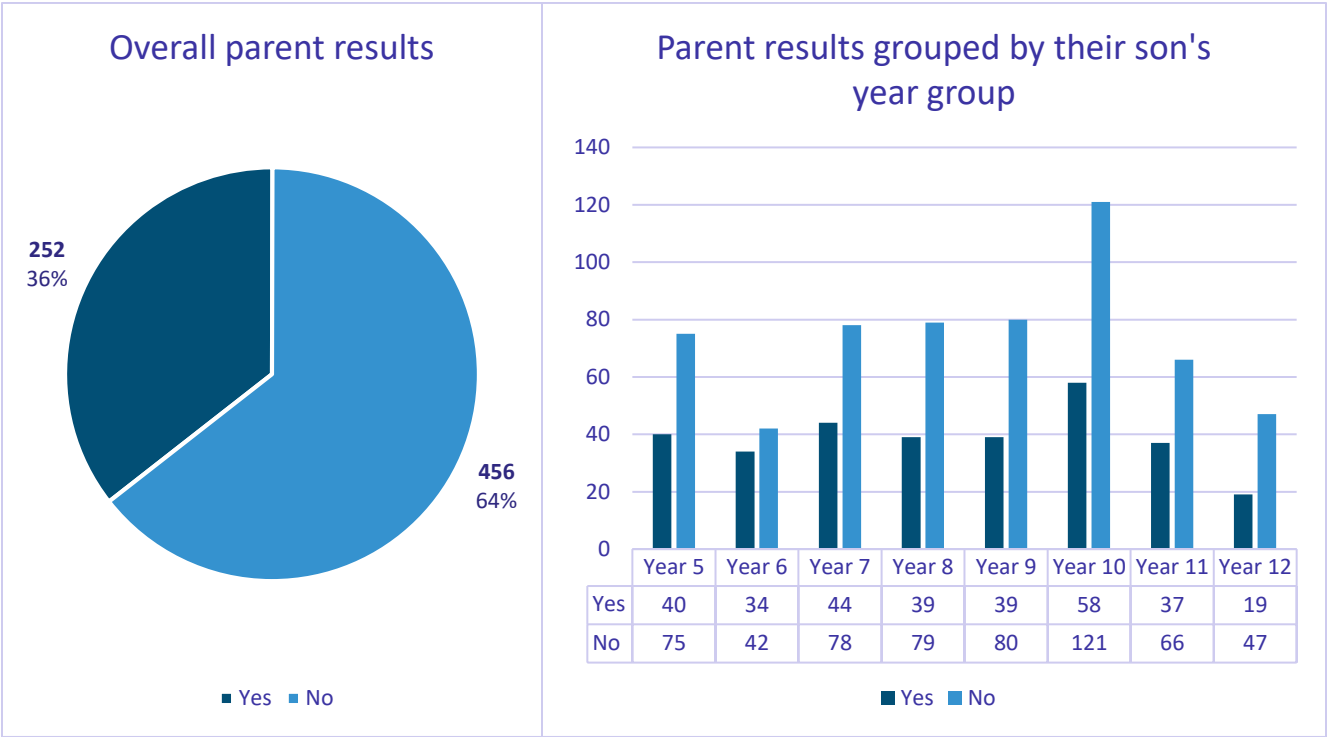

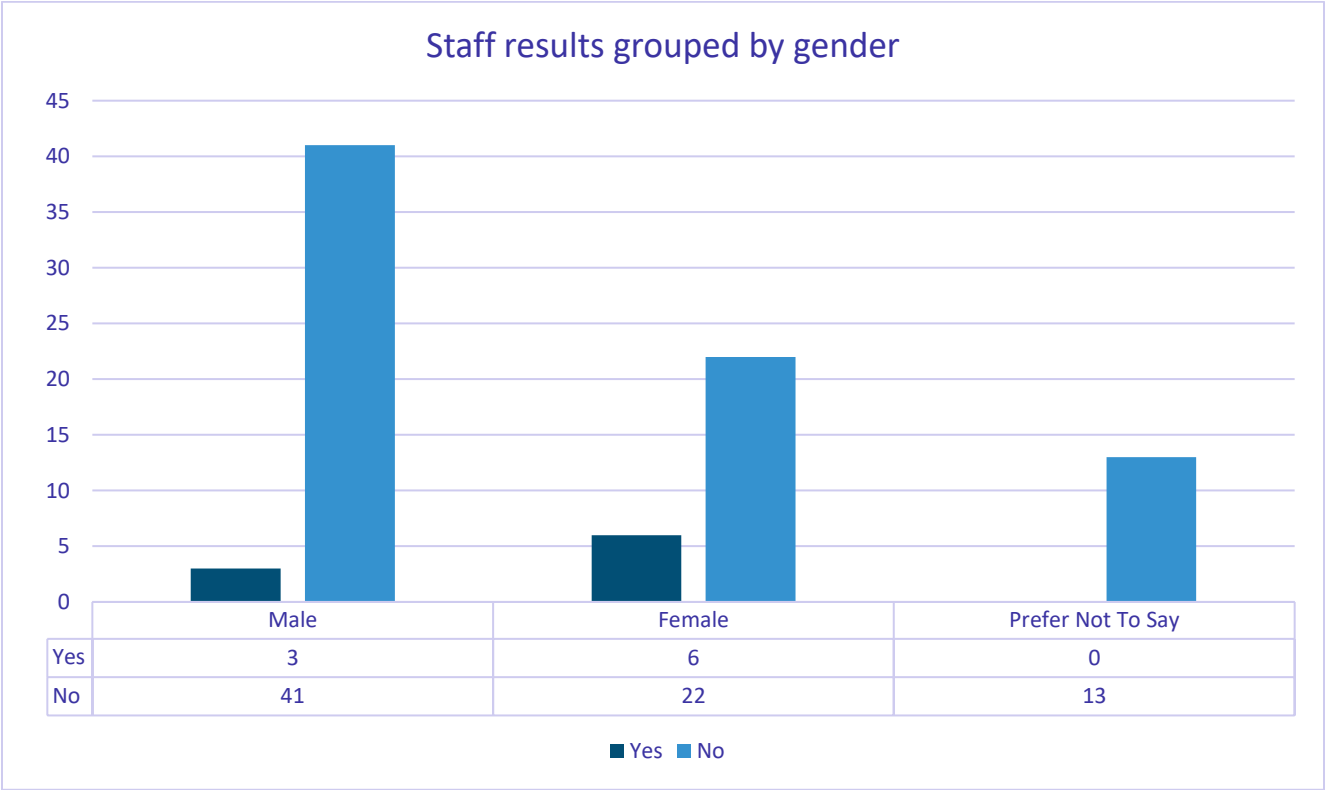
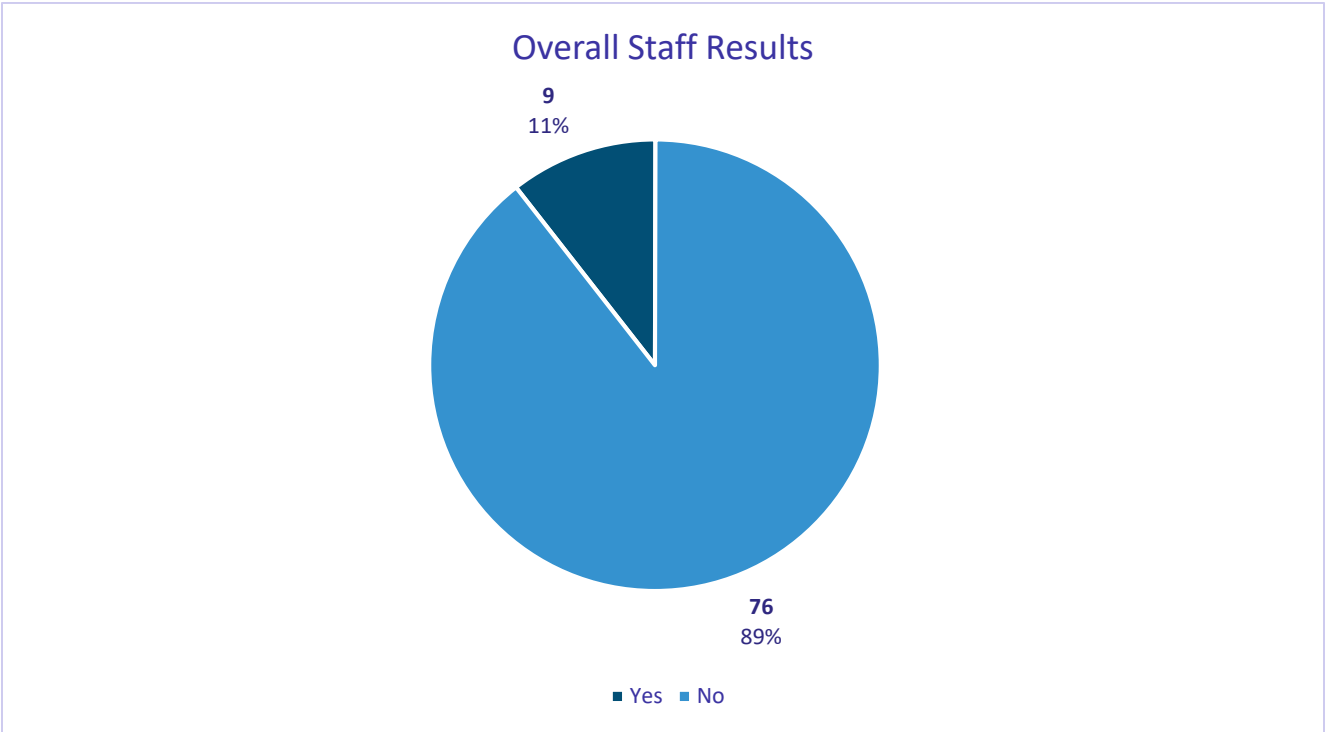

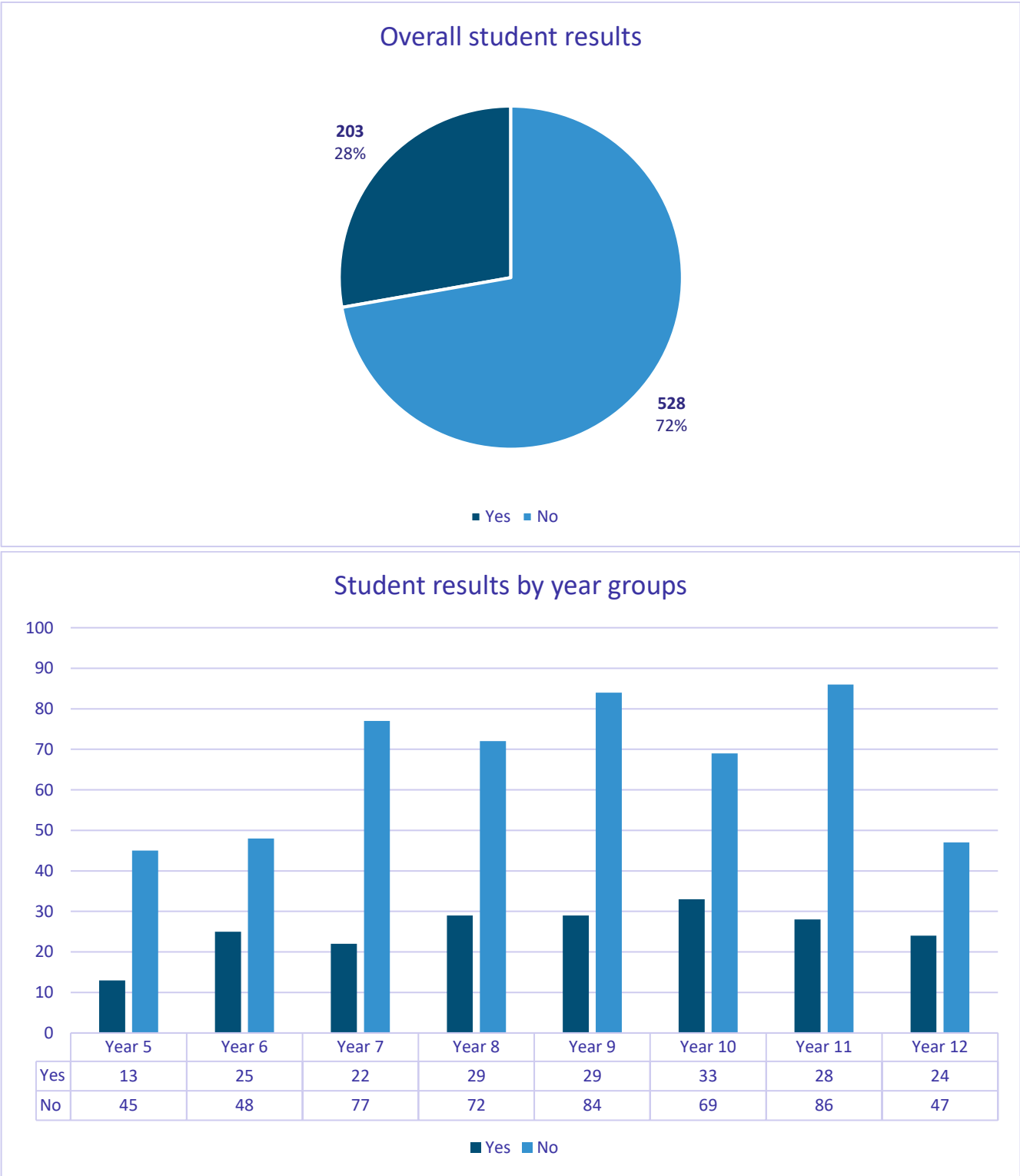

Conclusion

The survey was closed at 4:00pm on 1 April 2019 with 1524 participants; 708 responses from Parents, 731 responses from Students and 85 responses from Staff.

Regarding the question “Are you in favour of the introduction of a senior (Year 11 and 12) blazer?”, the overall opinion was ‘No’ with 882 responses opposing 642 ‘Yes’ responses.

For the question “Would you prefer the blazer to be for all year groups?”, the overall response was ‘No’ with 1260 outweighing the ‘Yes’ responses of 264.

Finally, the indication from the College community for the question “Are you in favour of the NEW blazer design?” is ‘No’ following 1060 responses opposing 464 ‘Yes’ responses.

Many of the comments left in the open field were regarding the purpose of such a change as well as a large concern for cost, environmental impact and dislike of the design.
