In the school age care setting all the interactions, experiences, activities, routines and events, planned and unplanned, that occur in an environment are designed to foster children's wellbeing, development and learning.

<u>Fitness Fun Day:</u> The children enjoyed taking part in a day filled with fun sports activities. They had the option to challenge each other to a 'Ninja Warrior Course' or have fun practising their soccer skills. With access to a variety of sports equipment, children were able to choose whatever activity they liked the most.
