ENGLISH

Reading and Viewing

- Using a range of reading strategies to gain meaning: Good Readers...
 - use the pictures for clues
 - make connections to their own experiences
 - make and check predictions
 - blend sounds together to read unfamiliar words
 - read smoothly and fluently
 - check that what they are reading looks right, sounds right and makes sense
 - read common words accurately
 - ask and answer questions about the text
 - make good guesses using the sentence context

Writing

- Generating, drawing and articulating writing ideas
- Listening for and recording the sequence of sounds in words
- Developing segmenting skills (ability to break words into individual sounds in speech eg. f-r-o-g, b-oa-t-s)
- Explicit teaching of 2 letter spelling patterns called digraphs (eg. ay as in tray, ng as in king)
- Using Capital letters for Proper Nouns and to mark the beginning of a sentence
- Using full stops to mark the end of a sentence
- Practising correct letter formations, sizing and spacing on dotted thirds

Speaking and Listening

- Sharing ideas and asking questions
- Displaying active listening skills

MATHEMATICS

- Addition
 - Using a range of efficient strategies to find the total of two groups of objects (counting on, doubles, near doubles, bonds to 10, subitising, number facts)
 - Explaining and justifying mathematical thinking- "How did you work it out? Prove it! Is there a more efficient strategy?"
- Length
 - Comparing ordering and matching objects according to length
 - Measuring length using uniform, informal units (eg. counters, blocks, tiles)
- Time
 - Drawing and describing the features and purpose of clocks
 - Reading o'clock and half past times

- Describing duration using months, weeks, days and hours
- Multiplication & Division
 - Using skip counting strategies to the total of a collection (eg. grouping and counting objects by 2s, 5s and 10s)

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Scripture & Jesus

Students will:

- explain God's relationship with people, using a variety of images of God from scripture
- interpret various images of God
- reflect on various scriptural images of God and identify those to which they have a personal connection

CONNECTED LEARNING
