Dear parents and carers,

**RE: Building works at the Blakeley Road campus**

As part of our current building project, Fairbrother have advised that asbestos will be removed from the site on **Saturday, 12 and 19 September from 8am to 5pm**. This work will be undertaken in strict accordance with the regulations by an expert asbestos removalist and an occupational hygienist engaged by the Department of Education and Training.

As a further precaution, air-quality monitoring will also take place during the removal, and a clearance certificate must be issued by the occupational hygienist before any person can access the area. Air-quality monitoring measures the number of asbestos fibres in an area. An area is safe to occupy and a clearance certificate can be issued, when the level of airborne asbestos fibres is below the limit of detection.

**It is important that the community are not onsite from 8am to 5pm while the asbestos removal occurs.** Neighbouring properties have been notified by letter.
