# **LEADERSHIP & MANAGEMENT**

- 2025 Prep Enrolments are underway. We will offer approximately 90 places for Prep 2025. 46 siblings have been offered places. Enrolment meetings for new families have been completed.
- The Annual report to the Community has been completed and is available on the <u>school website</u>.
- Capital works update:
  - Internal glass partitions and sliding doors are due for installation in the Boulevard during the June/July school holidays. This project is self funded by the school.
  - Plans are underway for a small hard surface with basketball rings. This is being funded by 2023/2024 fundraising.
  - We are waiting for Government Grant announcements in June for our Stage 4 build.

#### **EDUCATION IN FAITH**

- Whole school Holy Week and Alleluia liturgies were celebrated to mark the Easter Season.
- Our Sacramental Season is well underway with the Sacrament of First Reconciliation celebrated in week 1 of this term
- Our Eucharist Sacramental Family Faith Night was well attended by families. Our Confirmation Faith will be held on the 5th June.
- The Sacrament of Eucharist was a wonderful celebration for our students and families.
- Bishop Terry will visit the Year 6 students this week to discuss their preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- We look forward to celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation on the 15th June.
- Parish mass is being celebrated at 12pm each Friday led by a Year level.

# **LEARNING & TEACHING**

- Learning Conversations have been held as a key element in reporting learning to parents.
- Teachers are currently completing mid year assessments and moderation in preparation for Semester One Reports. We will once again include a Personal Comment.
- Extra curricular experiences this term include excursions to Scienceworks, Botanical Gardens, St Monica's Production of HairSpray, Cross Country, T-ball and Interschool Sports
