Music Excellence Scholarship

This Scholarship is available to students who have displayed outstanding aptitude, experience and commitment in Instrumental Music. Applicants should have a record of their involvement in musical performances, either solo or in a band performance. The successful applicant(s) will display outstanding work ethic and behaviour, and a preparedness to participate fully in the life of our College.

Number to be awarded — School discretion

Value - \$450.00 per annum / \$900 over two years

Rugby League Scholarship ENTRY AT YEAR 10 OR 11 – 2021

This scholarship is available to students who have demonstrated outstanding sporting skills in Rugby League and are interested in joining the VUSC Rugby League Academy at Year 10 or 11.
