Cultural Program Designers create and manage events, exhibitions, and activities that engage communities and promote arts, heritage, or cultural awareness. They work in museums, galleries, festivals, and community organisations to deliver creative and educational experiences.

- Strong communication and collaboration
- Understanding of cultural and community contexts

📚 How do they get started?

Most start with a bachelor's degree in arts, cultural management, or event management. Short courses or internships in program delivery can help build practical experience.
