Safe and respectful driving is a priority, and we have noticed an increase in concerns around driving behaviour during drop-off and pick-up times. We appreciate that the car park is particularly busy in the afternoons, but we are all trying to achieve the same outcome; our families will get safely out of the College. Your cooperation in addressing this by following these essential guidelines is greatly appreciated:

- Observe the 10km/h speed limit and all Give Way signs within the College grounds
- **Stop at crossings** your attentiveness could prevent an accident, perhaps even safeguarding your child or their friends
- Park in a designated car park If you need to wait for more than five minutes, to keep traffic flowing smoothly
- Give way to buses to ensure the safe movement of larger vehicles on campus
- Avoid tailgating, aggressive driving, or distressing other drivers
- Park legally in side streets. Respect our neighbours and their driveways

Above all, we ask that you treat everyone with respect. Allowing enough time for drop-offs and pick-ups can help reduce stress during busy periods. Please remember that driving on College grounds is a privilege, not a right.
