

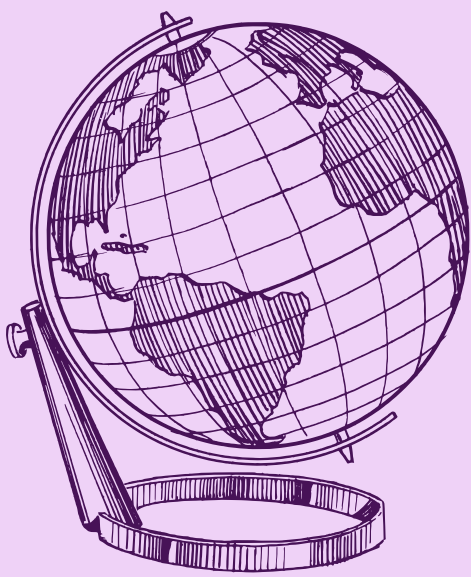
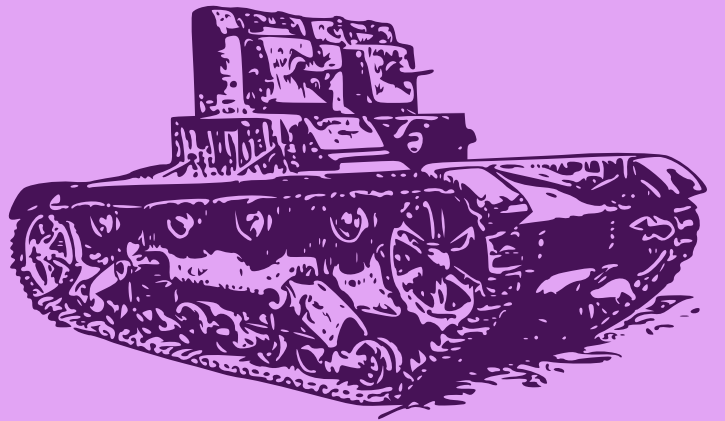

How did the world change after WWI?

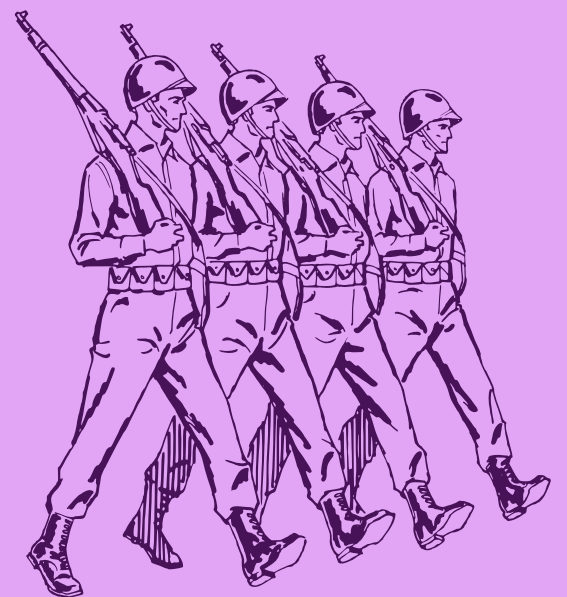


INTERWAR YEARS
