Clothing: Your child will need to wear his/her College Sport Uniform to the carnival. Two piece swimmers are not permitted for girls, where the midriff is bare. Please remember to pack a change of clothes, towel and something warm just in case.

Food: The Forum will be running a BBQ on the day and the venue café will also be open. However, it is advisable for you to pack your child plenty of water and food for the day including the journey to and from the carnival. We will be stopping at McDonald's for a quick breakfast and toilet stop, so you may wish to pack a small amount of money for this.

Transport: Due to the smaller number of students coming, please indicate whether you need transport or are planning to make your own way there. Depending on the response, we may take either the mini-bus or an 8 seater van driven by a teacher. I will contact parents by phone to confirm the arrangements.

Departure time: 5:30am sharp. We need to be at the venue by 8:20am for an 8:50am start. The carnival will conclude at 2:30pm. We should return to the College at approx. 5pm. Cost: Students are required to pay only **\$10** for the day (subsidised by the College). This includes venue entry and a convenors fee. There is a \$2.50 fee to enter the venue as a spectator. This should be paid on arrival to the venue.
