It is important to have my ears above the water and listen to the teacher when they are talking.

I will wait my turn during the activities.

I will keep my hands and feet to myself when waiting my turn.



My swimming teacher will tell me when the lesson is finished.

I will get safely out of the pool.

I will walk to the change room.
I will dry myself quickly and quietly and then get dressed.
I will respect others' privacy.
I will put all my wet clothes in my plastic bag.
I will put all my items in my swim bag.
I will go outside and see my teacher.
