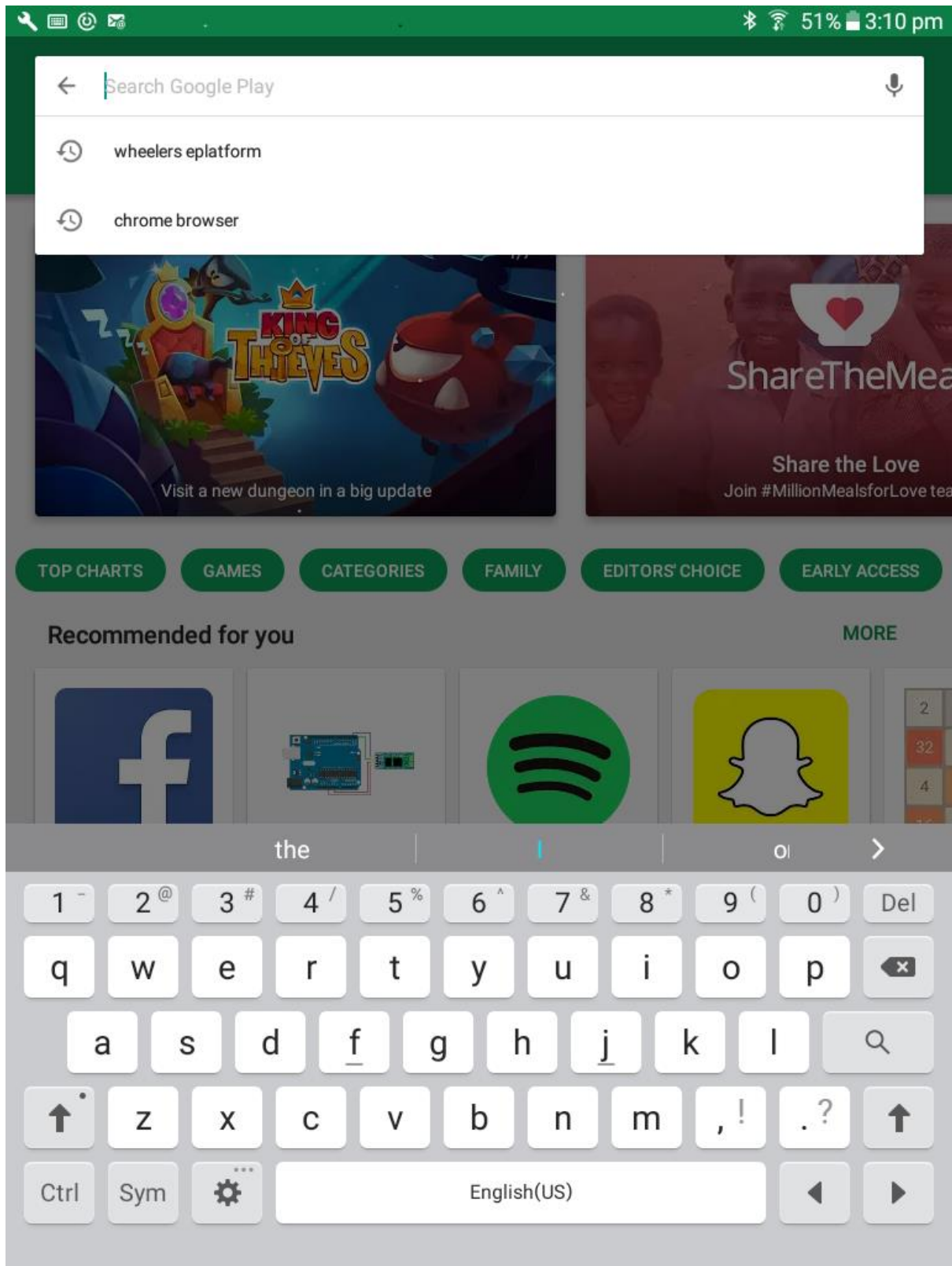
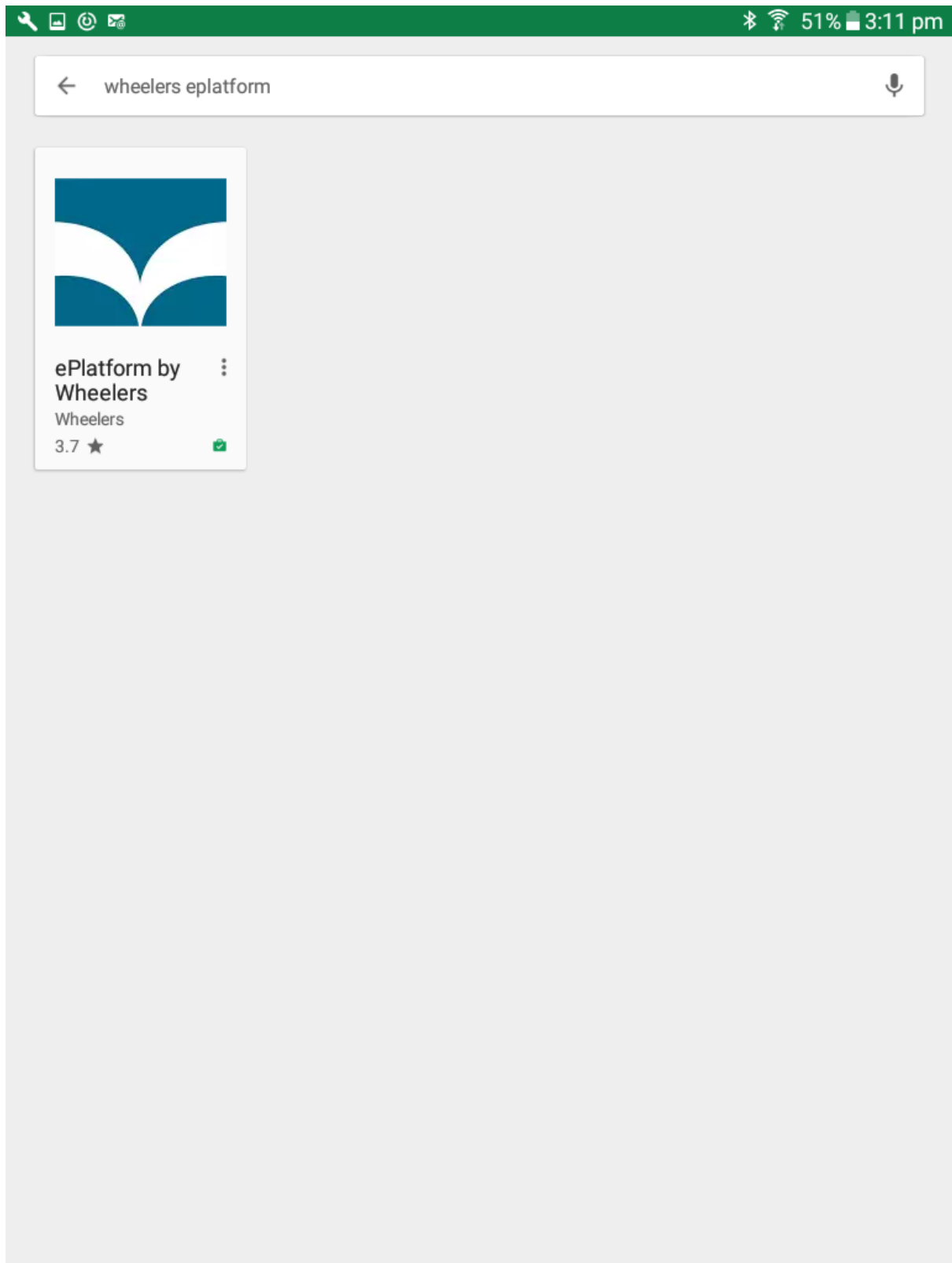


[How to use the MGC eBook Library](#)

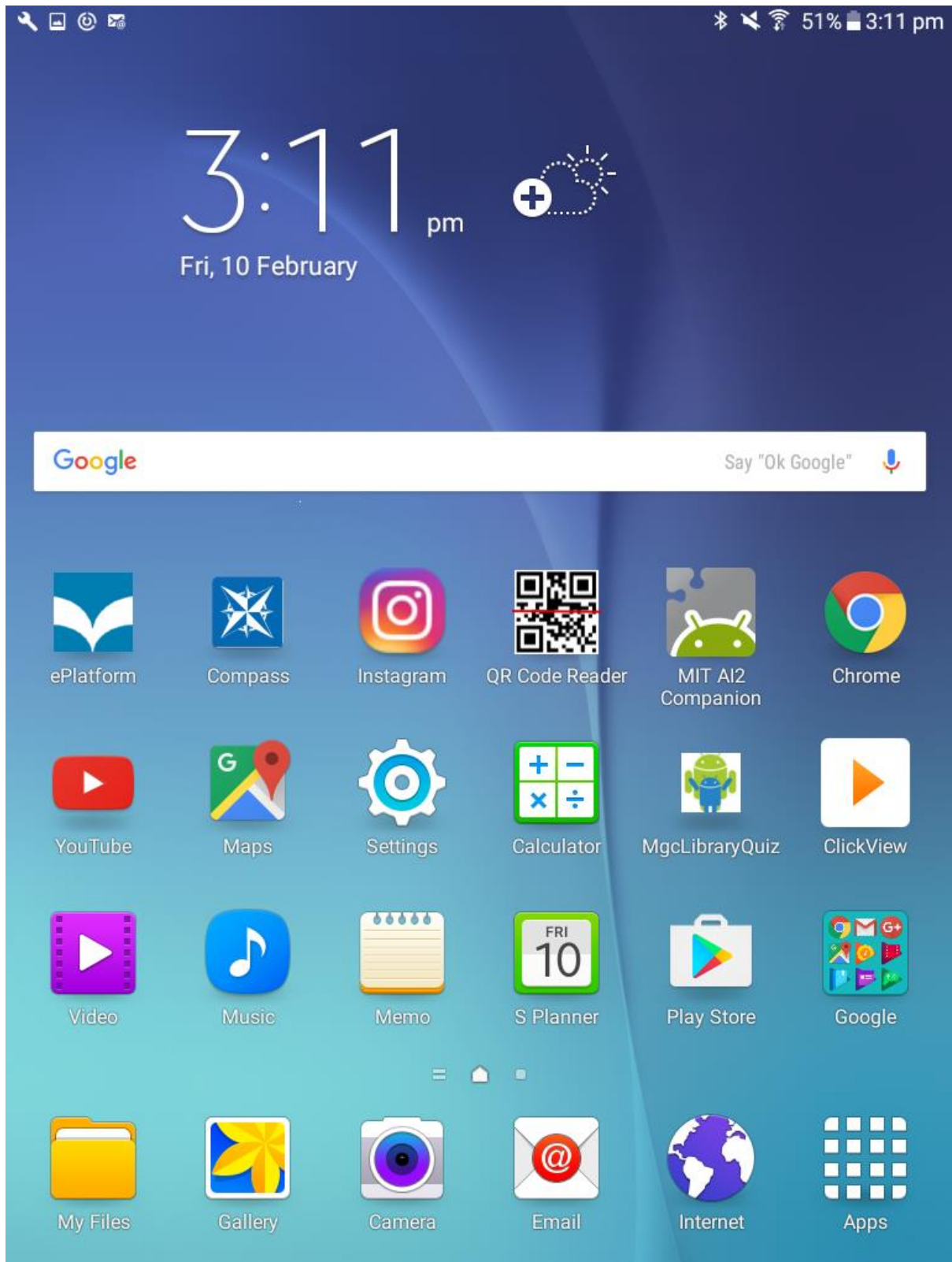
Open the device you wish to read the eBooks on (iPad/Tablet/Phone), then go to the app store and search for Wheelers eplatform.



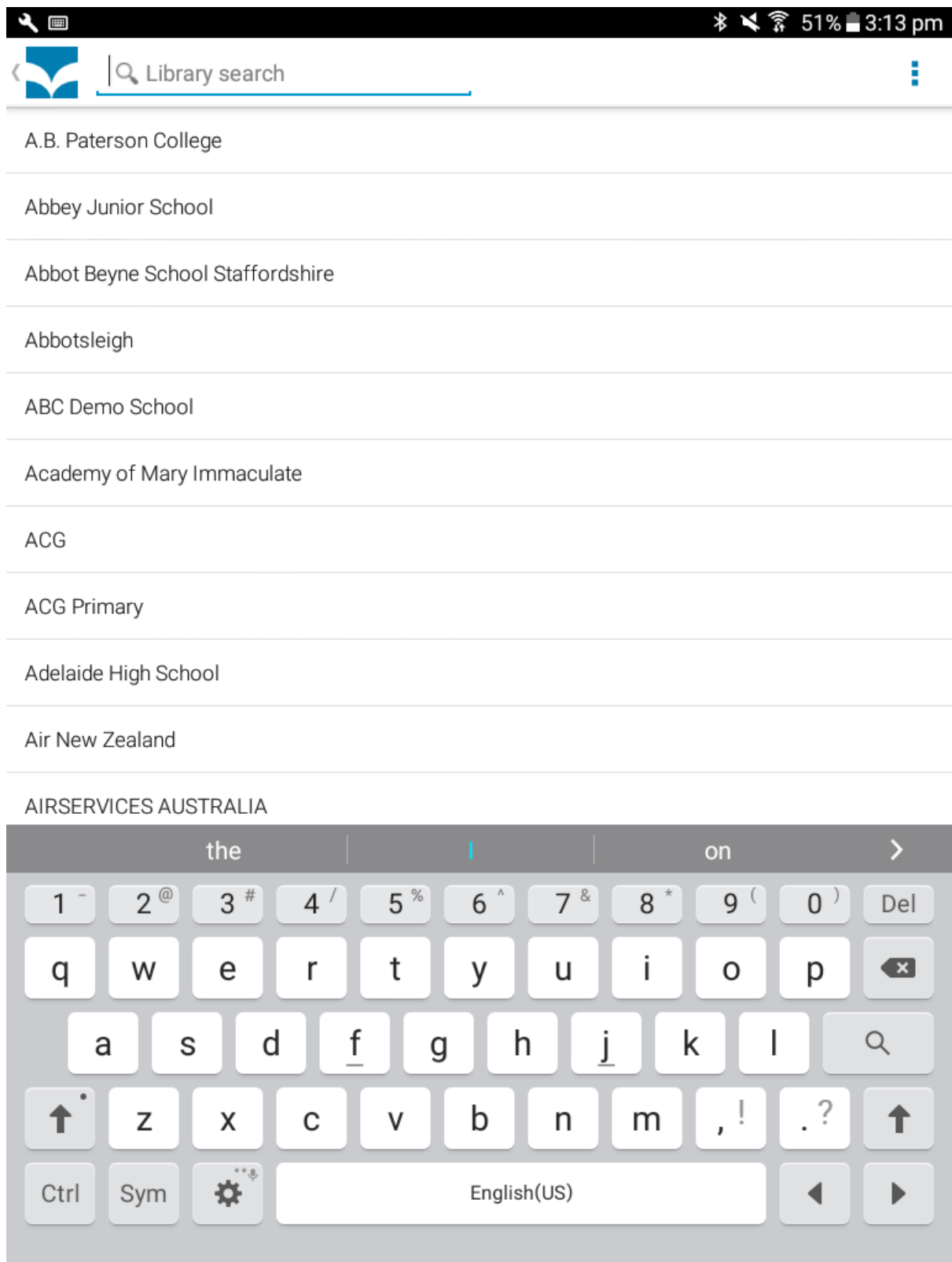
Click on the ePlatform icon and download the FREE app to your device.



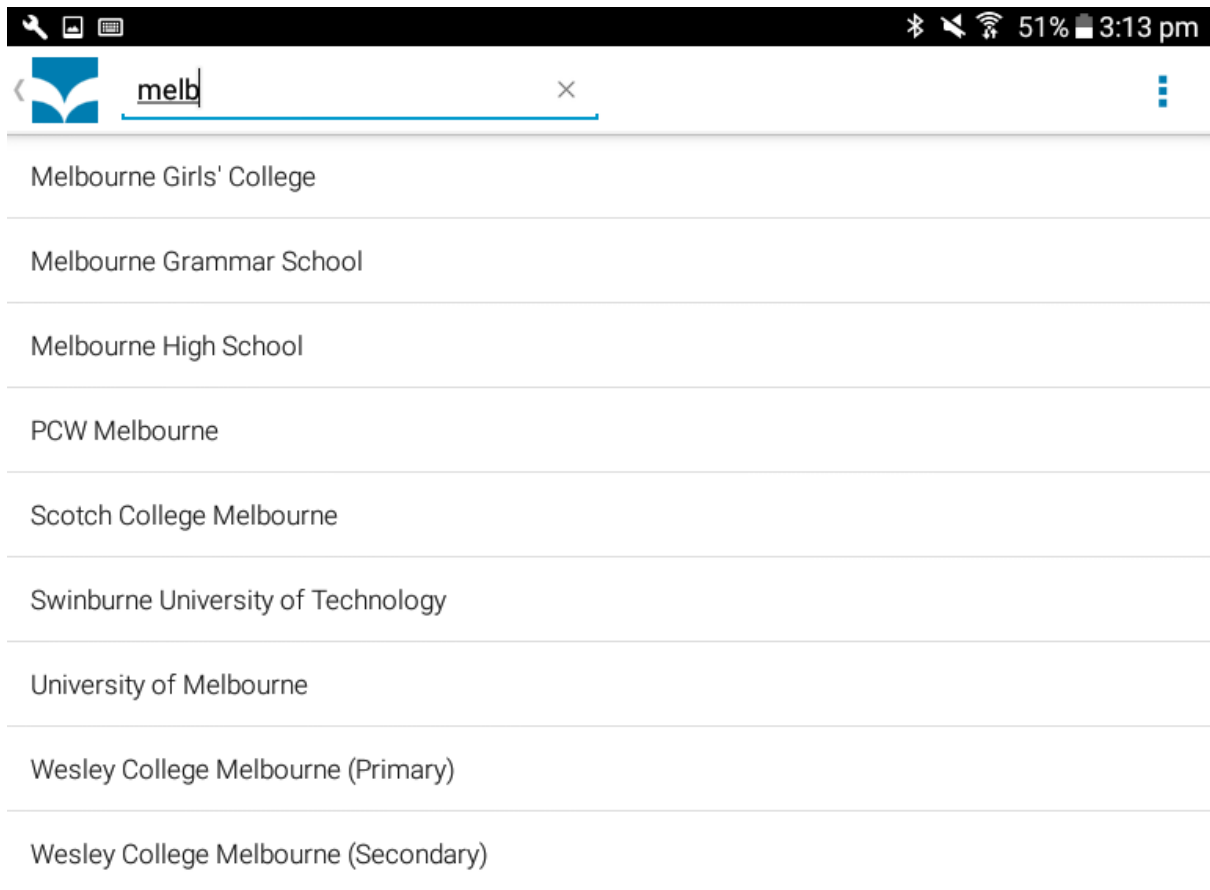
Open the app by clicking on the Wheelers ePlatform icon (shown top left here).




Open the Library Search. This will show a number of different schools.

On the top right of the page are some links; sign in, register, contact and support. Click on the *sign in* link.



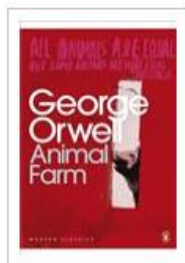
