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Try-A -Trade is not available to a student currently enrolled in a Construction VETiS qualification or already enrolled in any construction program the following calendar year. Student attendance is a minimum of 12 and a maximum of 16.

Students will need to be wearing a pair of steel capped boots and have a pair of clear safety glass for use whilst attending the course.
