<p>RELIGION</p> 	<p>Throughout this unit, students will learn about the books of the Bible. They will learn to identify the ways God’s people are portrayed in the Old and New Testament stories. They will learn that the Bible has key messages: Love all, Treat Others how you would like to be treated, Respect everyone. Towards the end of term, students will reflect on encounters with the Word of God and describe how it is lived out in the community.</p>	
<p>LITERACY</p> 	<p>The students will continue to attend daily spelling sessions where they will revise previously taught sounds and irregular words. They will also learn to read, write and spell new sounds and irregular words. The grade 2s will be focusing on saying and spelling the sounds: -able, -ible, uni-, bi-, and tri-. They will also be revising affixes that they have learned previously, to ensure they have had multiple exposures to the content and learning. The grade 1s will be focusing on saying and spelling the sounds: -ar, -or, air, are, and ear. They will also learn about the -y to i Rule.</p> <p>In Literacy, the students will be expanding their simple sentences by adding details such as who/what, when and where. The students will also be revising punctuation marks and when to use them in their sentences. Finally, the students will continue focusing on adjectives and adverbs, and they will be using these in their sentences to add even more depth.</p>	
<p>MATHS</p> 	<p>The Grade 2s will learn to recognise, compare and classify shapes, referencing the number of sides and using spatial terms such as ‘opposite’, ‘parallel’, ‘curved’ and ‘straight’.</p> <p>The Grade 1s will be learning to make, compare and classify familiar shapes; recognise familiar shapes and objects in the environment, and to also identify the similarities and differences between them.</p>	

INQUIRY



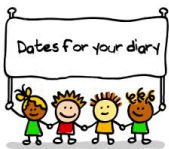
