The show performance details are as follows:

Cast 1 - Umbrella Cast - Performing Wednesday 10th of September, at 7pm.

Cast 2 - Kite Cast - Performing Thursday 11th of September, at 7pm.

Students in the production are requested to attend both performances. If your student has regular commitments on these afternoons/evenings, please arrange for them to have a catch-up session another time or miss them. Tickets will be available next Friday 15th of August at 9am. Seating will be allocated.

How the evenings will run:

Costumes:

Costumes will be provided for all students, however, due to health and safety regulations, we will be asking parents to provide smaller items for students, such as socks, stockings, shoes and/or any make-up required (which will be minimal but necessary on stage). Students will need the following:

Hats/props	Socks - black for boys or those in suits

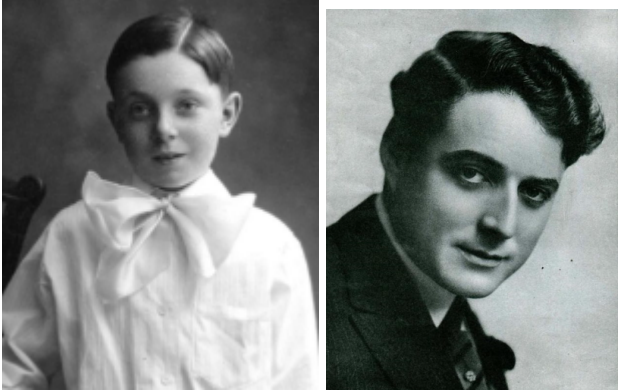
Clothing

- Undergarments such as a body suit/leotard or bike shorts and tight T-shirts, in case they need to change backstage to ensure they're covered up.
- Boys should have plain black shoes (not sneakers). School shoes would be perfect if they're not sneakers. Cheap examples can be found [HERE](#).
- Girls should have plain black Mary Jane style shoes, again school shoes are perfect if they're not sneakers, or click [HERE](#) for an example for girls and [HERE](#) for ladies sizes.

Hair

We'd prefer for students to have their hair done at home if possible.

Boys hair: please just have hair neatly done with a side part. Examples:



Girls with long hair: please have hair in a low bun or ponytail to allow for a hat.



Girls with short hair: please have side parted tidy hair (curling/waving is optional)



Certain characters will require slightly more for hair, those students and parents will be individually notified.

Make up

We'd prefer for students to have make-up applied before they arrive at school (both boys and girls). Please apply:

- Foundation one shade darker than their skin
- Lipgloss/lipstick (doesn't have to be bright, just a bit of colour)
- Some colour on their cheeks.
