MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2024

Students selected for this scholarship program will participate in a dedicated 90 minute weekly session as part of a group of 8-10 students from years 4-6. Sessions will run after lunch and will be held in the cottage, where musical equipment will be permanently set up.

This program will be led by Steve Skilbeck and Mark Muldoon, both accomplished musicians. This program will revolve around the formation of a school band. Students will build on their musical skills and apply those skills as part of the band. Once ready, the band will play at assemblies and other events. The band will be a feature act at the 2024 school concert.

Required musical equipment will be provided by the school, but those that would like to bring their own instruments are welcome to do so.

For this scholarship program, we're looking for students with a passion for music who would like to be part of a band. Participation will require a commitment to practising out of school.



SELECTION CRITERIA

- Demonstrated commitment to the school's values (Respectful, Responsible and Kind)
- A demonstrated interest in music, both at school and outside of school.
- The ability to sing or play an instrument.
- Demonstrated ability to collaborate with others.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Students currently in grades 3, 4 and 5 are now invited to apply for a spot in the 2024 Music Scholarship Program. Students from both campuses are invited to apply. The closing date for applications is Friday December 1st. To apply, students need to write a letter explaining why they would like to be participate and why they should be selected. Whilst students can apply for more than 1 scholarship program, they can only be selected for 1.

Students are also invited to include extra documents that demonstrate their interest and capabilities in music.

Please submit applications to the office staff. We do expect each of the scholarship programs will be over-subscribed, so it's likely we'll organise an interview with each application to ensure the best candidates are chosen.
