## Resignation of Jennifer Charadia, Principal, St Joseph's Catholic Parish Primary School, Bulli

After considerable reflection and prayerful discernment, Mrs Jennifer (Jen) Charadia, has decided to resign as Principal of St Joseph's Catholic Parish Primary School, Bulli. Her resignation will take effect at the end of the 2023 School Year.

Jen has made a significant contribution in her leadership of teaching and learning throughout her exceptional 25 years' of working with Catholic Education in the Diocese of Wollongong. In addition to her seven years as *Principal* at St Joseph's Catholic Parish Primary School, Bulli, Jen's tenure has also included the significant leadership positions of *Acting Principal*, *Assistant Principal* and *Acting Assistant Principal* at St Paul's Catholic Parish Primary School, Camden and Holy Family Catholic Parish Primary School, Ingleburn.

Jen has also worked in *Teacher*, *Coordinator*, *Middle Leader* and *Religious Education Coordinator* positions at St Mary's Catholic Parish Primary School, Eagle Vale (now Mary Immaculate) and St John's Catholic Parish Primary School, Campbelltown.

In 2009, Jen commenced a three year position working as an Education Officer within the Catholic Life and Religious Education team at the Catholic Education Office.

Jen's contribution to Catholic Education has been enormous, including an extensive music ministry, and I extend my sincere congratulations for her professional accomplishments. The St Joseph's, Bulli community will make the necessary arrangements to acknowledge, celebrate, and bid farewell to Jen in due course, recognising her significant contributions.

The substantive position of Principal at St Joseph's Catholic Parish Primary School, Bulli will be advertised as soon as possible.
